## Lake County's Centralized Dispatch Center

As of Wednesday, October 7<sup>th</sup> Police, Fire and Ambulance dispatching for the Town of Munster was transferred to Lake County's Centralized Dispatch Center. If

Police, Fire or Ambulance services are needed please dial 911. The call center will determine if the call is an emergency or a call for service. Should a business or resident need to report or cancel an alarm they should also dial 911. To report an after hours Public Work's emergency such as a water main break or downed tree blocking the roadway please dial 911.

The Munster Police Department's previous non-emergency numbers, 219-836-6600 and 219-836-6601, are no longer operational. To contact an officer, Police Administration, the Detective Bureau or the Record's Division please dial **219-836-6650**, during normal business hours. To contact any employee or department of the Town of Munster please dial **219-836-8810**.

#### **Online Credit Card Payments**


Many have asked about online credit card payments. The day has arrived!

You may go to <a href="www.munster.org">www.munster.org</a> and click on "Pay Utility Bill" to pay your bill with a credit card with no fee. If you have ever used our online bill pay in the past, be sure to refresh your browser so it takes you to our new online bill pay service. You may bookmark the site directly with: <a href="www.munster.org/">www.munster.org/</a> utilitybill.

You will need to know your 9-digit account number and the **numbers only** of your address. If your address is 1234 Main St, you will enter only **1234** in the second box. You can find your account number on your monthly bill, see diagram below.

Another feature available is viewing your monthly bill online. This does not look *exactly* like the bill you receive in the mail, but very similar. You can see the totals and the breakdown of the bill. The balance listed on the webpage is current as of the business day prior and when you make a payment it will show on your account 1 to 2 *business days* after payment. Please be patient with us as we tweak the user interface on this feature The bills you receive in the mail will not change, this online feature is just an added service to better serve our customers.

#### **News for Snowbirds**

It is that time of year that some of our residents may be planning their winter away from the cold and snow. If you are a part of that group, please remember a few things:

- You will need to continue to pay the minimum bills. Setting up automatic payment (ACH) is the best way to be sure those bills are paid on time and the correct amount is paid. Please remember that you will be charged a late fee if an amount goes unpaid. You may call us at the beginning of any month to check the balance due.
- We can also temporarily send your bills to another address if you prefer. Just let us know where to send them temporarily. When you get back to town, call us again to have the bill sent to your local address.
- If you want your water turned OFF, you must schedule a time for our maintenance staff to turn the water off (this is the only way to suspend billing). For your protection, it must be a time when someone will be there to confirm it is off. There is a \$20 fee to turn the service off and a \$20 fee to turn it back on. That DOES save you money if you are going to be gone for several months. Remember that we will not turn service on to an empty house, so call us one business day in advance to set an appointment time when you can either be there yourself or can have someone you trust with access to the home be there to confirm when service is turned on that there are no issues inside your home.

#### Leaf & Branch Pick Up

The Town of Munster's branch pick up will end on *Friday*, *November 13*, 2015, and the Fall Leaf pick-up will end on *Friday*, *December 4*, 2015 (weather permitting).

The Public Works Department must now transition towards preparing for snow and ice removal.

Please do not put leaves in your garbage can or in bags, Waste Management will not pick them up. Rake your leaves to the curb for Munster's Fall Leaf Collection.

#### **Holiday Season Safety Tips**

Throughout the holiday season, the Munster Police Department encourages residents and businesses to make note of these important safety tips:

- Always shop with a friend when possible for safety purposes.
- Keep your wallet in your front pocket or your purse zipped up and slung in front of you (never placed in a cart) while you are shopping. Beware of distraction techniques that pickpockets use (such as bumping you or asking you for directions while an accomplice steals items) in grocery stores, malls, or other crowded areas.
- Never leave purchased items in plain view inside of your vehicle when shopping. Store items in your trunk, or take the items home as soon as possible.
- Try to park in a well-lit area. If you are concerned about walking out to your vehicle, talk to the store about your concerns or you can even request an escort from police (the store can call for you if necessary).
- To protect your home, let the police department know that you will be going on vacation by contacting Officer James Ghrist at 219-836-6639 with the dates/ times that you will be gone, along with your address or any other specific arrangements and he will pass it along to the patrol officers.
- Residents should also keep their homes well-lit during the evening hours using timed, motion-detecting, or dusk to dawn lighting. Keep bushes trimmed below the window line to limit hiding places. Also, try not to lay out large amounts of holiday gifts in plain view through the window.
- Report suspicious activity in your neighborhood immediately by calling 911.
