RE: Chemicals and Fertilizer for 2015 season

The golf course maintenance department has been busy assessing its chemical and fertilizer needs for the 2015 season. The golf operation looked at what has been successful and also taken a look at some changes that should be more beneficial. Based on this direction, vendors were contacted and received a request for pricing for products that will be used on the golf course.

Below are the lowest prices for all products with the exception of fertilizer application #2 and #3. These products did not meet the specifications that were requested:

- Has a much larger particle size than requested
- Has caused turf burn and damage in the past
- Does not last as long
- leaves cart tracking issues and damage
- Doesn't provide any nutrient value to help with turf rooting
- Causes speckling or spots throughout the fairways
- Releases desired nutrients at an uncontrollable rate
- Referred to as a "hot product," which means it has more of a burn potential
