On Saturday, June 11, 2016 at approximately 8:40 p.m., Lieutenant Kurt Matz was working a side detail at Centennial Park. At this time, guests at a wedding reception were eating their dinner, when an elderly male guest exited the banquet room and came into the hallway with his wife. The elderly male was choking and his airway was obstructed by food. Centennial Park bartender Gary Quillon recognized that the man was in serious distress and applied the Heimlich Maneuver which dislodged the trapped food from the man's airway. Lieutenant Matz believed that this quick action by Mr. Aquillon saved this man's life and his actions are worthy of recognition.
