

**TOWN OF MUNSTER**  
**MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION**  
**JUNE 9, 2014**

A regular meeting of the Munster Redevelopment Commission convened at 8:22 p.m. on Monday, June 9, 2014, at the Munster Town Hall. Commissioners John W. Edington, Andy Koultourides, David B. Nellans, and John P. Reed, were present. Commissioner Joseph A. Simonetto and School Town of Munster Representative Judy Florczak were absent. Mr. Reed presided. Also present were Executive Director Thomas F. DeGiulio, Assistant Town Manager Clay T. Johnson, Attorney Eugene M. Feingold, Chief of Police Stephen F. Scheckel, and Town Engineer James M. Mandon. The news media were represented by Jim Masters of *The Times*.

Mr. DeGiulio explained to the Commission that Staff will be coming to them soon with a report on work that needs to be done at the Munster Business Complex. Decisions need to be made on repair work and whether or not some buildings should remain.
