A RESOLUTION ENDORSING A ROUTE FOR BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN USE IN THE TOWN OF MUNSTER

Whereas, The Town of Munster seeks to encourage bicycling and hiking in, across, and/or through Munster and connections beyond Munster to benefit by the 47-billion-dollar industry of touring by non-motorized means of transportation; and

Whereas, The Hoosier Rails to Trails Council ("HRTC") and other groups are promoting the United States Bicycle Route System ("USBRS") through Indiana; and

Whereas, HRTC wishes to work with local communities and connections to extend branch routes from the USBRS across parts of Indiana to link with bordering states and thereby build the Hoosier Hike and Bike Centennial ("HH&BC") System; and

Whereas, The Town of Munster agrees to designate a person as route coordinator to work with HRTC in advising on local and long-term maintenance of this route and on promotion of the HH&BC System; and

Whereas, HRTC has investigated the proposed route and found it to be a suitable route, and desires that the Town of Munster designate it to be mapped with optional signage as a part of promoting bike and hike tourism in Munster and its connections; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That the Town Council of the Town of Munster hereby expresses its approval and support for the development of the HH&BC Project, and allows that signs may be placed within the local community identifying the route.
