Snow Removal Ordinances

Please read and remember the Town of Munster's ordinances for snow removal.

Ordinance:

It is hereby declared and proclaimed that it is necessary to the public health and safety that the streets of the town be cleared of snow, and if the clearing of snow is impeded and delayed by vehicles parked on the streets, such impediment and delay is detrimental to the public health and safety.

Whenever there has been snow of two inches or more, in order not to delay the clearing of such streets, all vehicles parked on all streets of the town, except streets in the area bounded by, but not including, Manor, Hohman, Ridge Road, and the northern town limits, shall be removed by the owner. These are the one-way streets between Manor and Ridge Road in the northwest section of town.

If such vehicles are not removed from the streets after two inches of snowfall occurs, and after ticketing, it shall be the duty of the police department of the town to forthwith employ some reputable person to remove such vehicles from the streets.

Ordinance:

The owner and/or occupant of any dwelling, building or subdivided lot or property shall keep the sidewalks in front thereof clean at all times of the year. Within 24 hours after any fall of snow or formation of ice, such snow or ice shall be removed from the sidewalks.

It shall be unlawful for any person to throw, push or deposit in any manner snow, slush or ice onto any street or sidewalk in such a manner as to impede the safe progress and movement of vehicular or pedestrian traffic.

Persons who violate this subsection are responsible for the costs incurred by the town to remove the impediment to safe progress and movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic.

If you believe that a residence or business is not following this ordinance please contact either the Munster Police Department by calling 911 or you can report the matter to Community Service Officer Russell Shelton at 219-836-6659 for follow-up. If the situation is an extreme safety concern, always call 911.

Be Prepared

At home and at work.....

Primary concerns are the potential loss of heat, power, telephone service and a shortage of supplies if storm conditions continue for more than a day.

Have available:

- Flashlight and extra batteries.
- Batter-powered NOAA Weather Radio and portable radio to receive emergency information. These may be your only links to the outside.
- Extra food and water. High energy food, such as dried fruit or candy, and food requiring no cooking or refrigeration is best
- Extra medicine and baby items.
- First-aid supplies.
- Emergency heating source, such as a fireplace, wood stove, etc.
 - * Learn to use properly to prevent a fire.
 - * Have proper ventilation.
- Fire extinguisher and smoke and CO detector.
- Test units regularly to ensure they are working properly.
- Back up generator for your home or business.

In cars and trucks...

- Plan your travel and check the latest weather reports to avoid the storm!
- Fully check and winterize your vehicle before the winter season begins.
- Carry a WINTER STORM SURVIVAL KIT:
 - * blankets/sleeping bags;
 - flashlight with extra batteries;
 - * first-aid kit;
 - * knife;
 - * high-calorie, non-perishable food;
 - extra clothing to keep dry;
 - * a large empty can and plastic cover with tissues and paper towels for sanitary purposes;
 - * a smaller can and water-proof matches to melt snow for drinking water;
 - sack of sand (or cat litter);
 - * shovel;
 - windshield scraper and brush;
 - * tool kit;
 - tow rope;
 - booster cables;
 - * water container;
 - compass and road maps.
 - * Keep your gas tank near full to avoid ice in the tank and fuel lines.
 - * Try not to travel alone.
 - * Let someone know your timetable and primary and alternate routes.

Kindergarten and New Student Registration for 2016-17

Parents of Kindergarten students and new students for the 2016-17 school year are asked to visit their home school at their convenience during the week of March 7-11 from 10 am to 3 pm to begin the registration process.

In order to be eligible to register for Kindergarten a child must be five years old on or before August 1, 2016. To register for first grade a child must be six years old on or before August 1, 2016.

At the time of registration, parents must present a **certified/ original birth certificate** of the child, and a valid driver's license with the current address. (Baptismal and hospital records are not acceptable as proof of birth). At registration parents will be asked to complete a student information sheet for their child. Parents will receive information on how to complete registration and residency. Parents will also sign up for an appointment to complete the residency process.
