1. CALL TO ORDER

President Pierce called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. with a quorum.

2. ROLL CALL

4. PUBLIC COMMENT

Johnathan Peterson, 10240 White Oak Lane, on behalf of Munster residents and friends of the NWI Cricket Association, praised how the cricket pitch at West Lakes Park distinguishes Munster as a community. Mr. Peterson, along with those involved with the use of the cricket pitch, are encouraging the Board to approve the development of the washroom building at the Park.

5. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

- a. Approval of Park Board Minutes
 - i. January 21, 2025 Minutes

Board Member Paulsen moved with a second by Board Member Smith to approve the January 21, 2025 minutes. Board Members Guiterrez, Paulsen, Repay, Smith and Pierce voted in favor; none voted against. Motion passed and the minutes were approved.

- b. Confirmation/Approval of Park Vouchers
 - i. Approval of Voucher Register 25-2A dated 2/18/25 totaling \$171,947.70
 - ii. Confirmation of Voucher Register 25-2B dated 1/1-31/25 totaling \$190,256.53
 - iii. Confirmation of Voucher Register 25-2C dated 2/17/25 totaling \$2493.00

 Board Member Paulsen motioned with a second by Board Member Smith to approve Park

 Voucher Registers 25-2A, 25-2B and 25-2C. Board Members Guiterrez, Paulsen, Repay,

 Smith and Pierce voted in favor; none voted against. The motion passed and the Voucher

 Registers were approved.

c. Reports

i. February Board Report
 The Report was included in the agenda packet. The Director answered some questions.

ii. Town Council Liaison Report Councilman Gardiner reported that at their meeting yesterday the Council approved giving stipends to employees with certifications. It will reward further education of all employees.

6. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/ACTION

a. Lease Agreement with School Town of Munster
The lease agreement as presented has been approved by the Council and the School Board
and now comes before the Park Board. The agreement calls for the lease of parts of
Community Park for the construction of new tennis courts for the high school.

Board Member Repay motioned with a second by Board Member Paulsen to approve the
Lease Agreement between. Board Members Guiterrez, Paulsen, Repay and Pierce voted in
favor; Board Member Smith abstained; none voted against. Motion passed and the Lease
Agreement was approved.

b. 2025 Ford Explorer Purchase

Per the Repair & Replacement Schedule the Park Department vehicle is scheduled to be replaced. I was decided by staff not to get another van as an SUV suits the Department's needs. Proposals were solicited and only two were returned. Bosak Ford of Burns Harbor submitted the lowest price for a 2025 Explorer Active in the amount of \$21,359 after trade in of the existing van. The Director recommended the Board approve the purchase.

Board Member Repay motioned with a second by Board Member Smith to approve the purchase of a 2025 Ford Explorer Active in the amount of \$21,359. Board Members Guiterrez, Paulsen, Repay, Smith and Pierce voted in favor; none voted against. Motion passed and the purchase was approved.

- c. Centennial Park Golf Management Presentation Centennial Park Staff presented the 2024 Centennial Park year in review.
- d. Professional Services Agreement with CSK Architects

Staff have been working with CSK Architects to develop a conceptual plan for a restroom and storage facility at West Lakes Park to better serve the users of that facility. The conceptual plan and the professional services agreement to furnish architectural and engineering services were included in the agenda packet. The proposed Scope of Work is for a lump sum fee of \$26,000. The Director recommended the Board approve the agreement and authorize him to sign it.

Board Member Repay motioned with a second by Board Member Smith to approve the Professional Services Agreement submitted by CSK Architects for a lump sum of \$26,000 and authorize the Director to sign it. Board Members Guiterrez, Paulsen, Repay, Smith and Pierce voted in favor; none voted against. Motion passed and the purchase was approved.

e. Professional Services Agreement with HWC Engineering
Discussion was had on a professional services proposal from HWC Engineering for further
developing plans on what to do with the Clubhouse area at Centennial Park after the building
is demolished. The item was tabled. The Director will be asking HWC to revise the proposal
and submit a ne one for consideration at the next Park Board meeting based upon the input
from discussion.

7. ADJOURNMENT

President Pierce called for a motion to adjourn the meeting.

Board Member Paulsen motioned with a second by Board Member Repay to adjourn the meeting. Board Members Guiterrez, Paulsen, Repay, Smith and Pierce voted in favor; none voted against. The Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned at 5:51 p.m.
