Re: Scrapping of Brinks Truck

Approximately five (5) years ago Brinks Incorporated donated an old armored truck to the Munster Police Department to be utilized by our Regional Swat Task Force. Part of the agreement was that we would notify them when we were finished with the vehicle, and if necessary assume any cost involved with destruction of truck.

As you are aware the Police Department recently received a brand new Mine Resistant Ambush Protected (MRAP) vehicle from the military in August of this year. Consequently, we no longer have a need for the Brinks truck. Sergeant Peirick contacted Brinks per our agreement and updated them on the condition of their truck. Brinks agreed that the truck should be scrapped, and advised Sergeant Peirick that any proceeds from the scrapping of the old truck revert back to the Munster Police Department.

Scrap Metal Services, of Burnham, Illinois is currently in possession of said vehicle though is awaiting the title. In order to transfer the title and allow Scrap Metal Services to scrap the truck I am respectfully requesting the Munster Town Council make a motion that the Brinks vehicle be declared surplus inventory and therefore is eligible to be destroyed.
