Proclamation Raising Awareness of Falun Dafa

During the April 27, 2015, meeting of the Munster Town Council, Ms. Lisa Zhu requested the Council to adopt a proclamation in support of Falun Dafa, a form of physical and mental exercise. As a result of conversations with Ms. Zhu, the following proclamation resulted.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

By motion and roll-call vote, adopt the proclamation "Raising Awareness of Falun Dafa."

PROCLAMATION

Raising Awareness of Falun Dafa

WHEREAS, Americans are fortunate to live in a country that embraces the many cultures and religions of the world; and

WHEREAS, Individuals prosper when their minds and bodies are strong; and

WHEREAS, Practice of the spiritual movement known as Falun Dafa or Falun Gong enables high-level development of the mind, accomplished through meditation, as well as cultivation of the body, accomplished by performing specific exercises; and

WHEREAS, Though not a religion, Falun Dafa facilitates stress reduction, health improvement, and spiritual growth through its teachings which emphasize truthfulness, compassion, and tolerance; and

WHEREAS, In the mid- to late-1990s, the Chinese Communist Party and public security organizations increasingly viewed Falun Dafa as a potential threat due to its size, independence from the state, and spiritual teachings, resulting in efforts to eradicate the practice beginning on July 20, 1999; and

WHEREAS, It has been reported that millions of Chinese people have since been abducted, improisoned, tortured, fired from jobs, expelled from school, or forced into homelessnes because they practice Falun Dafa; now, therefore, be it

PROCLAIMED, That the Town Council of the Town of Munster does hereby proclaim July 20, 2015, to be Falun Dafa Day in the Town of Munster, and encourages all Munster citizens to become aware of this spiritual movement.
