

## **ORDINANCE 1813**

### **AMENDMENT #5 TO THE 2020 SALARY ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, The Town Council adopted Ordinance 1786 which established the 2020 Pay Plan for the Town of Munster; and

**WHEREAS**, The Town Council took various steps to address the Coronavirus pandemic and to be in compliance with Executive Orders of Indiana Governor Eric Holcomb; and

**WHEREAS**, The Town Council restricted operations without reducing pay of employees for a period of time in response to Executive Order 20-08 which directed Hoosiers to stay at home; now, therefore, be it

**ORDAINED**, By the Town Council of the Town of Munster, Lake County, Indiana, that regular full-time employees will be paid for forty (40) hours of regular pay even if fewer hours were worked for the time period of March 25, 2020 through May 4, 2020; and be it further

**ORDAINED**, By the Town Council of the Town of Munster, Lake County, Indiana, regular full-time employees will receive full benefits during the period of March 25, 2020 through May 4, 2020 even if fewer than the required number of hours were worked during that time period.
