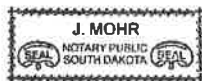

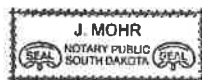

The Oblige has notified the Principal and the Surety in writing at their respective addresses of the alleged breach with a detailed description thereof, and has requested and attempted to arrange a conference with the Principal and the Surety to be held not later than fifteen (15) days after receipt of such notice to discuss methods of performing the Contract; and has made available during the notice period all books, records, and accounts relevant to the Contract which may be requested by the Principal or Surety. If the Oblige, Principal and Surety agree, the Principal shall be allowed a reasonable time to perform the Contract; but such an agreement shall not waive the Oblige's right, if any, to subsequently declare a Principal default;
 - b. The Oblige has declared the Principal in default and formally terminated the Principal's right to complete the Contract, provided, however, that such default shall not be declared earlier than twenty (20) days after the Principal and the Surety have received the notice as provided in "a" above; and
 - c. The Oblige has agreed to pay the balance of the Contract price to the Surety in accordance with the terms of the Contract or to the such contractor as may be tendered by the Surety to the Oblige.

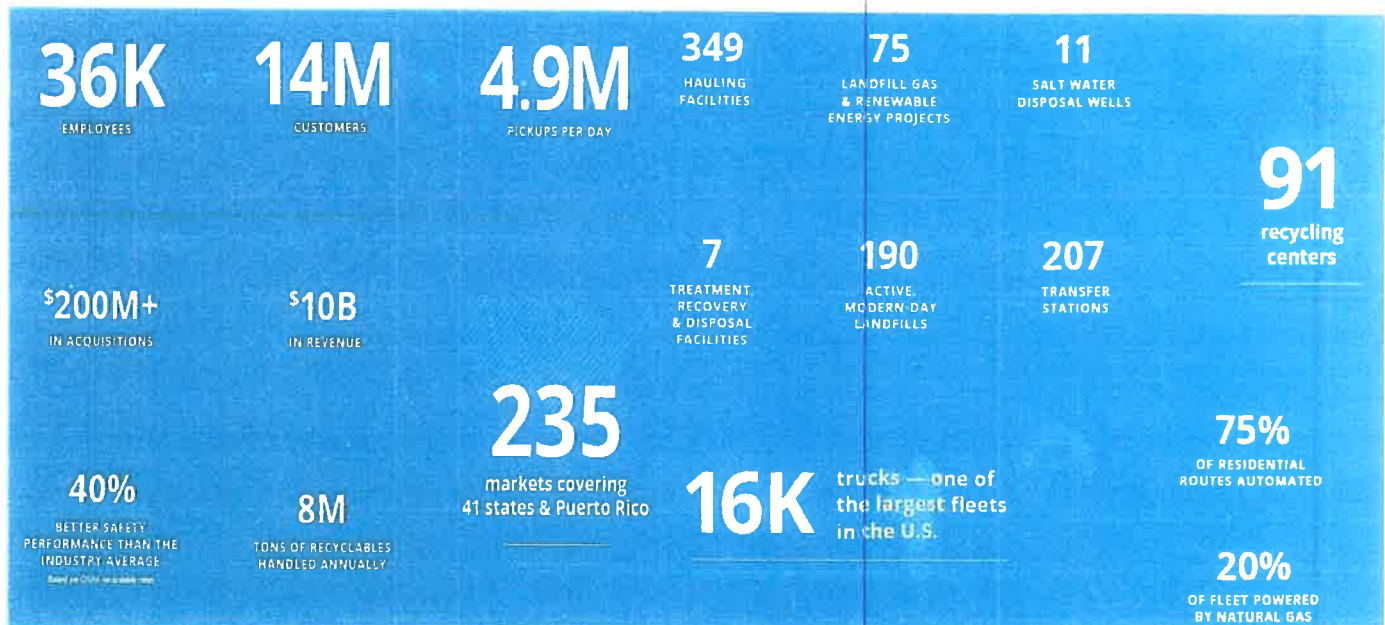

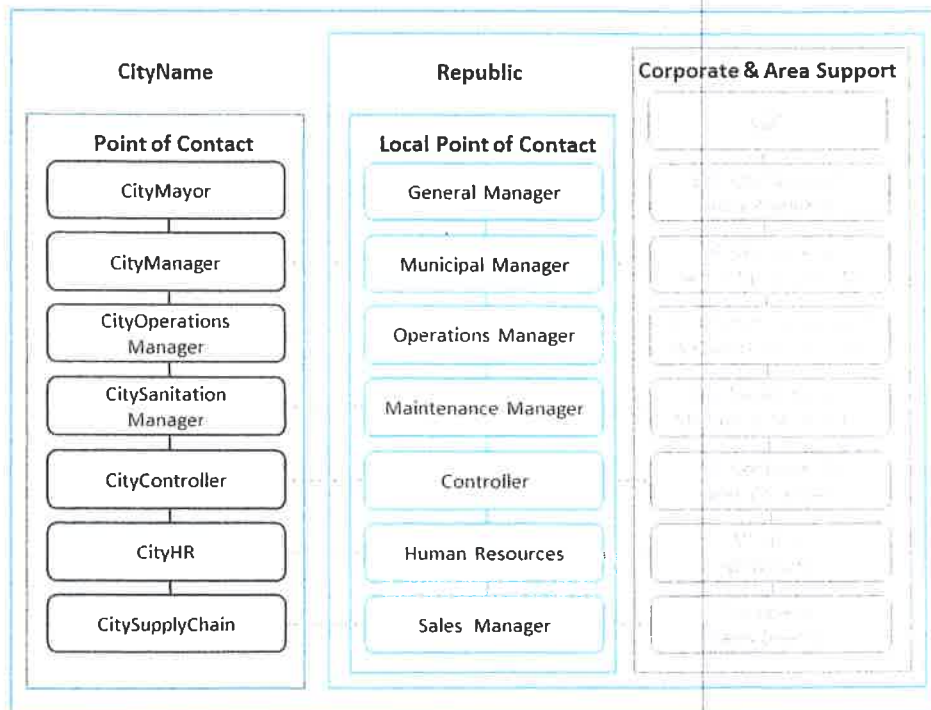

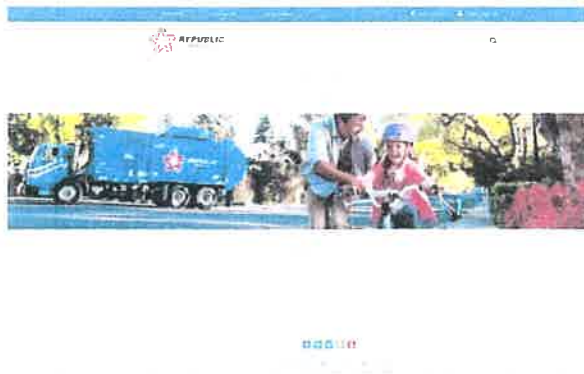

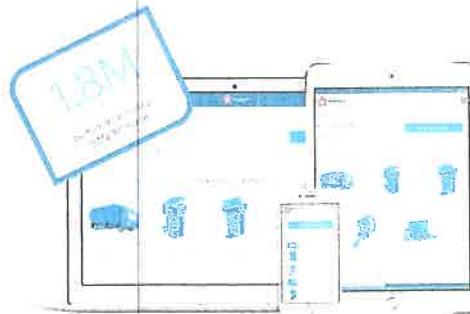

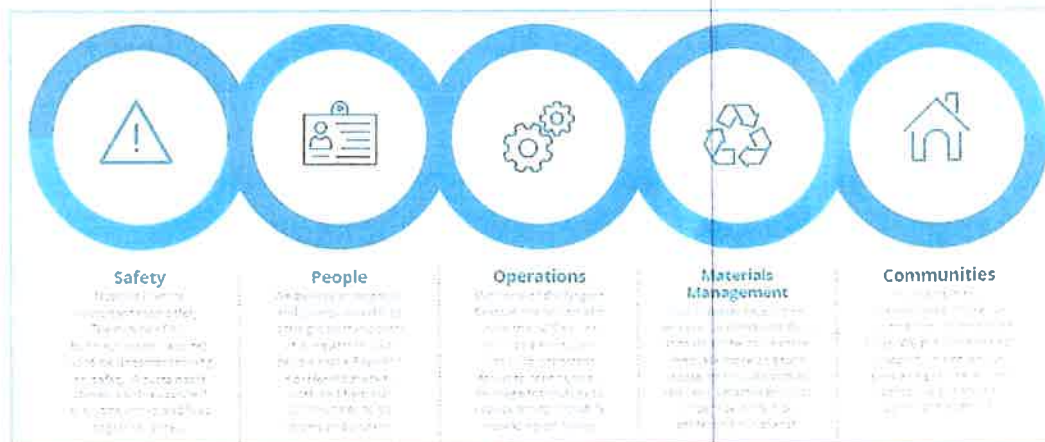

The benefit of this clean energy project is equivalent to planting more than 20,000 acres of pine or fir forests or removing 18,000 motor vehicles from the road. When the project is at optimal operating levels it will produce almost 800 standard cubic feet per minute.

The Newton County Landfill is a major employer and community supporter. The Company converted an abandoned factory in Morocco into a customer support center employing 112 county residents. Through the landfill's good neighbor agreement, Republic has contributed to parks and recreation facilities, public safety and government facilities.
