Subject: Repeal and replace several form ordinances

Occasionally, it is necessary for the Town of Munster, the Board of Parks and Recreation, Staff, and consultants to reviewed and recommended various changes, and to repeal and replace the Munster, Indiana Code. The following have been reviewed and updated:

- a. The Department of Parks and Recreation, its funding, and the rules and regulations within parks and recreational areas in the Town of Munster (Ord 1832); and
- b. The specific devices that are encompassed in the term "bicycle" and what provisions of the Munster Code of Ordinances apply to the operation of a "bicycle;" (Ord 1833); and
- c. The Regulation of Consumer Fireworks (Ord 1834); and
- d. The Smoke-Free Air Regulations for Workplaces and Public Places (Ord 1835); and
- e. Various changes to the Munster, Indiana Code regarding Special Event Permits (Ord 1836); and
- f. The General Provisions of Chapter 54, Traffic and Vehicles, of the Munster Code of Ordinances, specifically, penalties for violations of the Traffic Code, compliance requirements of Chapter 54, regulation of traffic in the designated bike lane on the roadway, and the Town of Munster Ordinance Deferral Program (Ord 1837); and
- g. Various changes to the Munster, Indiana Code regarding Chapter 1, General Provisions, of the Munster Code of Ordinances (Ord 1842); and
- h. The Schedule of Fees and Charges, Schedule A, be revised, updated, and increased where appropriate (Ord 1843)
