Hours of Operation: Monday-Saturday – 11am-6pm

Sunday - 1pm-6pm

July 4 – Pool Closed

Admission: 2 and under – FREE

Children and Adults – \$10 R/\$15 NR

Seniors (65+) - \$8 R/\$13 NR

Infants two and under are free with a paid adult. Youth ages 16 or younger must be accompanied by a paid adult. To receive the Resident rate, Munster and Highland residents must show proper ID.

To be considered a "Resident", one must possess a current Driver's License or State ID showing Munster or Highland residency. A family is identified as parent(s) and/or any unmarried children who are living at a single residence. Passes are per individual and cannot be shared.

Season pass members will be given a laminated picture card to submit upon each entry to Munster Pool. Should member lose the card, a \$5 charge will be assessed to replace.

Group Rates

Resident: \$7/person NR: \$12/person

- Minimum group size of 15 people.
- 1 adult chaperone per 10 children admitted free.
- Chaperones must be in the pool with children at all times.
- If crowded, groups may not use lawn chairs.
- No food or drink may be brought in you can get your hand stamped to exit to eat and then re-enter.
- Groups must be booked in at least 3 days in advance with the Superintendent of Recreation. No on-site groups will be taken.

^{*}Should your party exceed 250 guests, you will be required to pay a \$45/hour security fee for each hour booked plus an extra 30 minutes prior to and after your rental. Rental hourly fee + 7% tax + refundable deposit + security (if applicable) are all due at the time of booking. Private Parties must fill out a questionnaire about their event prior to booking. They will be given a checklist upon clean-up. This will determine if deposits are refunded.

Adult Open Swim: Season Pass perk to those 18 years or older. Open Swim will take place on Sundays from 11:45am-12:45pm. Members will be required to exit the gates after open swim ends to re-enter for the day should they wish to stay. They may not leave belongings in the pool to save chairs.

Bathing Attire/Flotation Devices: Bathing suits are required for swimming at Munster Community Pool. Shorts and athletic wear are not considered acceptable bathing attire. Floatation devices (ie. life rings, noodles, inflatable tubes) are not allowed. Only Coast-Guard approved life vests (no suits with built-in flotation) are allowed. We offer complementary use of life vests to our pool patrons thanks to a generous donation from Munster Community Hospital.



Recommendations for 2022 Pool Season

 Keep clothes out of the pool – we will increase signage around the pool consisting of posters and ground stickers.

- Add admission person outside gate check bags/coolers for food, drinks and glass. They
 will also enforce swimsuit materials also. Water cooler will be available in concession
 area for bottle refills.
- At the admission gate patrons will be required to print, date and time stamp a sheet that states no street clothes allowed in the pool. This way we can gauge time frame they are there to enforce no refunds due to swim materials.
- Slide requirements increase from 42" to 48" both red and blue slide.
- If a child is saved more than 2 times in 1 day, that child will be given a wristband from the pool manager to stay in the zero depth area. If they are saved again, they are asked to leave with no refund and/or remain out of the water.
- If we can, we would like to install 2 cameras.
 - o 1 existing that views from concession stand area out over pool and deck.
 - Existing camera has not been active for many years.
 - o 1 new that views from pump house out over pool and deck.
