ORDINANCE 1840

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE TOWN OF MUNSTER POLICE DEPARTMENT STATE ASSET FORFEITURE NON-REVERTING FUND (292)

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Munster, Lake County, Indiana, has determined that it is advisable, necessary, and in the best interest of the residents of the Town of Munster to establish a State Asset Forfeiture Non-Reverting Fund into which state forfeiture proceeds will be deposited. Expenditures from the Police Department State Asset Forfeiture Non-Reverting Fund shall be used for the purpose of the non-budgeted public safety and public safety related matters by the Munster Police Department as allowed by law IC 34-24-1-9(b)(1); and,

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 36-1-3 provides for the establishment of funds for accounting purposes; now, therefore, be it

ORDAINED, By the Town Council of the Town of Munster, Lake County, Indiana, that the State Asset Forfeiture Non-Reverting Fund 292 is created as follows:

- 1. That there is hereby established that any monies received from the Indiana state forfeiture proceeds be deposited into the State Asset Forfeiture Non-Reverting Fund (292).
- 2. That the monies deposited into the State Asset Forfeiture Non-Reverting Fund (292) shall be utilized and expended only for the purposes of non-budgeted police public safety and police public safety related matters.
- 3. That the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of Munster, Indiana, is authorized and directed to take all appropriate and required steps to establish said State Asset Forfeiture Non-Reverting Fund (292) in conformance and compliance with all applicable laws, as amended from time to time.
- 4. That all existing Town Code Sections and Ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance, are hereby deemed null, void, and of no legal effect, and are specifically repealed.
- 5. That if any section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid of unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, provision, or portion of this Ordinance.
