RE: Main Street Patching

Background

Schererville Town Councilor Kevin Connelly recently reached out to the Town Manager with concerns about the pavement condition on Main Street. Mr. Anderson spoke with Schererville's Director of Operations and provided him with an update on the design for the Main Street reconstruction project from Columbia Avenue to Hart Ditch. He also advised the Town's intent to secure additional funding to reconstruct the remaining portion of Main Street from Hart Ditch to the Highland town line. This construction, however, will not begin for several years and the condition of the pavement in this area is poor.

Methodology

Public Works staff met with Schererville PW in September to walk the area and identify the worst sections to mill and repave. Milestone Contractors North, Inc. has provided a quote of \$166,320 to complete the work. The figures below illustrate the scope of the work.

Hart Ditch to Woodhollow



Woodhollow to Cypress



An interlocal agreement has been proposed between Munster, Schererville, and Dyer to split the cost of the patching evenly between the three municipalities. The final cost to Munster would be \$55,440.00.

Dyer will contract with Milestone through their 2023 patching contract. As Schererville has provided most of the leg work regarding the design and scoping of the project, Munster will provide oversight during the construction.

Recommendation

By motion and voice vote, approve the interlocal agreement with Schererville and Dyer to patch Main Street between Hart Ditch and the Highland town line.
