Staff have been working with CSK Architects to develop a conceptual plan for a washroom building at West Lakes Park to better serve the users of that facility. That concept plan is attached along with a professional services proposal for your consideration. The building would include storage area for cricket, soccer, the Town and women's and men's washroom facilities.

Mark,

I want to thank you in advance for the opportunity to work with the Town of Munster's Park Department for the Proposed West Lakes Park Improvements. The scope of work will be per the approved preliminary design we provided.

Per your request, we propose to furnish Architectural and Engineering Services to include Preliminary Design, Design Development, Construction Documents, Project Manual with Specifications, Assistance with the Public Bid Process for the work and all necessary On-Site Observations/Construction Administration Services including submittals review process and progress meetings for the proposed work. We have also included the task of submitting the Project along with the required Energy Efficiency Calculations to the Indiana Department of Homeland Security (IDHS) for a Construction Design Release (CDR). We have not included the cost of the application fees for the IDHS CDR which will be treated as a reimbursable expense.

We also propose to coordinate and assist the Parks and Recreation Department with requesting quotes for Geotechnical Services to perform soil borings and the Geotechnical Construction Services for the project.

Based upon the above information and the revised proposed scope of work we propose to perform this work for a lump sum fee of \$26,000.

We have not included any costs or fees for Soil Borings, Geotechnical Construction Services, Environmental Surveys, Furniture, Furnishings or Equipment design or procurement.

We propose that any other Additional Services requested or required will be handled either as a proposed additional lump sum fee or on our standard hourly rates.

Other than the above we will not have any additional reimbursable expenses what so ever.

Please let me know if you need further assistance or have any questions in regard to this proposal. I am also available to discuss this proposal at your earliest convenience if you require. Once again, I appreciate the opportunity to submit our revised proposal to you and the opportunity to work with you.



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
