- → Exhaust fan. Maintenance will be done one time per year. Belts will be included.
- → Condenser Maintenance. Spring start-up, check refrigerant pressures, Check contactors and electrical controls, Check operation.
- → Condenser Coil washing. Will be completed on a summer visit.
- → Guaranteed Priority Emergency Service Response: Our Maintenance Program Agreement has continuously proven to reduce emergency or trouble calls. However, when one does occur, you will receive our highest priority response. Arctic Engineering responds to emergency service and trouble calls even during peak periods typically under four (4) hours or less of your call.
- → Programmed Maintenance Performed Around Your Schedule: We have incorporated your business and technical requirements into this maintenance program. Our call center automatically dispatches the manufacturer's recommended maintenance procedures for your equipment on a predetermined schedule that best meets both your business and your equipment requirements.

#### **ADDITIONAL SERVICES**

- → Corrective Maintenance and Component Replacement Coverage: The main objective of this Maintenance Program Agreement is to maintain your equipment at optimum efficiency. During the course of executing the maintenance procedures, our technicians are trained to identify impending problems and repair them before they cause unplanned downtime. You will be informed of any required repairs. Arctic Engineering will only perform these repairs with your approval. Upon completion of any required repairs Arctic Engineering will remove all defective parts.
- → Emergency and Trouble Call Coverage: Even with the comprehensive care provided in this program, occasional failures can occur. Emergency response is available 24/7 between scheduled visits, Monday through Sunday, including Holidays additional to this program.
- → Refrigerant Containment Service: We will leak test and report needed repairs on any equipment found low of refrigerant. We will use recovery, recycling and reclamation of your refrigerant as appropriate to minimize costs of replacement refrigerant. Such work will be done per all federal, state and local regulatory guidelines.
- → Service Documentation: We will document all scheduled and unscheduled service work showing the time, date, name of service technician, and equipment identification and brief description of work.
- → Performance Assurance Program: We will meet with you annually or more frequently upon request to evaluate and make modifications, if necessary, to this maintenance program to assure that it continues to meet both your business and technical requirements.

## IMPLEMENTATION TEAM of the MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

*Munster Centennial Park Pro Shop & Cart Barn* shall receive a 10% discount for any parts and material utilized for emergency service and repair work beyond the scope of this agreement.

*Munster Centennial Park Pro Shop & Cart Barn* shall be billed at a discounted labor rate of \$169.00 per hour for emergency service and repair work beyond the scope of this agreement. *(labor rate is subject to change June 1<sup>st</sup> without written notice except when requested)* 

This Maintenance Program Agreement will be for an original term of one (1) year, beginning <u>June 1 2025</u> to <u>May 31 2026</u>. At end of the original term of this agreement, the program will automatically renew from year to year. Either party may terminate this agreement with written notice forty-five (45) days before the end of the renewal date.

#### The annual investment in this program is \$2,228.00

The annual agreement price shown above can only be adjusted if equipment is added or deleted from the original agreement. Price adjustments after year one are discussed in the terms and conditions of this agreement.

Payment terms will be thirty (30) days after *Arctic Engineering's* date of invoice. *Arctic Engineering* reserves the right to discontinue its service anytime payments have not been made as agreed. Failure to make payments when due or impairment of customer's credit shall relieve *Arctic Engineering* of any and all obligations pertaining to work or performance of work.

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- **A.** Planned and or routine maintenance services provided under this agreement shall be performed during normal working hours.
- **B.** The guarantees and services provided under the scope of this agreement are conditioned upon *Munster Centennial Park Pro Shop and Cart Barn* operating and maintaining systems/equipment in according to industry-accepted practices and in consideration of our recommendations.
- **C.** This agreement does not include responsibility for system design deficiencies, such as, but not limited to poor air distribution, water flow imbalances, etc. It does not include responsibility for system, equipment and component obsolescence, electrical failures, unserviceable equipment, and operating the system(s).
- **D.** Arctic Engineering shall not be liable for delays or failure to obligate due to fire, flood, strike, lockout, freezing, unavailability of material, riots, acts of God, or any cause beyond reasonable control.
- **E.** Arctic Engineering shall not be responsible for the removal or disposal of any hazardous materials or any cost associated with these materials unless otherwise noted in this agreement.
- F. This agreement does not include repairing any damage resulting from improper/inadequate water treatment or filter service not supplied by *Arctic Engineering*.
- G. This agreement does not include any services occasioned by improper operation, negligence, vandalism, or alterations, modifications, abuse, or misuse, or repairs to equipment not performed by *Arctic Engineering*.
- **H.** *Arctic Engineering* shall not be required to furnish any items of equipment, labor, or make special tests recommended or required by insurance companies, Federal, State, Municipal or other authorities except as otherwise included in this agreement.
- I. In the event either party must commence a legal action in order to enforce any rights under this contract, the successful party shall be entitled to all court costs and reasonable attorney's fees as determined by the court for prosecuting and defending the claim, as the case may be.
- J. *Arctic Engineering's* scope of work shall not include the identification, detection, abatement, encapsulation or removal of asbestos or products or materials containing asbestos or similar hazardous substances.
- **K.** This agreement does not include the disposal of hazardous waste; any charges incurred for their proper disposal will be born by the customer as an extra to the contract price.
- L. Should the contract be canceled without due cause, the customer shall pay *Arctic Engineering 25%* of the annual price in addition to any previous amount paid.
- M. This agreement investment price may increase at the time of renewal.
- N. Labor rates are subject to change without written notice except when requested.
