

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU"), is made and entered into as of \_\_\_\_\_

**BETWEEN:** The Town of Munster, Indiana (hereinafter the "Town")

**AND:** The Firefighters Association of Munster, Indiana (hereinafter the "FAM"), hereinafter the "Participants."

### I. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of this MOU is to set forth the various responsibilities regarding the purchasing, licensing and insuring of a certain 1939 Ahrens-Fox fire engine that was previously owned by the Town ("Engine"). The Engine is currently owned by a private party who is willing to sell it back to the Town.

### II. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS MOU

The Participants shall be responsible for the following activities:

- A. The FAM shall negotiate with the current owner of the Engine and establish the purchase price for the Engine together with the costs, if any for transporting the Engine to Munster, IN.
- B. The FAM shall be responsible for funding the purchase of the Engine by making a donation to the Town in the amount of the purchase price and transporting cost.
- C. The Town shall be responsible for purchasing the Engine from the current owner and having the title, if any, placed in the name of the Town of Munster, Indiana.
- D. The Town shall be responsible for insuring and licensing the Engine so long as it is owned by the Town.
- E. The Town of Munster, Munster Fire Department shall keep, maintain and repair the Engine when and if necessary, in the ordinary course.
- F. The Engine shall be housed in a Munster Fire Department station house or other enclosed facility dedicated to fire department use.

### III. DURATION

No time limits, however, should the Town choose to sell or otherwise dispose of the Engine, FAM shall have the right of first refusal to purchase same from the Town for the total cost of One Dollar (\$1.00).
