Munster's Fireworks Ordinance

Munster Fireworks Ordinance states that consumer fireworks may be discharged within the corporate limits of Munster from

June 29th through July 3rd, and from July 5th through July 9th between the hours of 5p.m. and 2 hours after sunset. On July 4th consumer fireworks can be discharged between the hours of 10:00 a.m. - midnight.

Please note, however, that fireworks must be discharged on your own property (not in the streets/ park) or on the property of someone else without permission. You must be 18 yrs. To possess or discharge fireworks unless accompanied by a supervising adult.

Violators of this ordinance can be fined by the Munster Police Department.



Charge Piles

The Town of Munster charges a fee for collection of large amounts of garbage, debris and/or yard waste. When the Street

Department determines a collection would be excessive, a letter is left on your door. The minimum collection fee is \$130. The letter must be signed and returned before collection will be scheduled. If you have any questions, you can contact the Public Works Department at 836 -6971.



White Goods

The town will pick up white goods on Wednesdays. White goods are washers, dryers, refrigerators, freezers, dishwashers, microwaves and hot water heaters. If you have a white good to be

picked up, please call the Town of Munster Public Works Department at 836-6971 and give us your address. All other large items can be put out for Waste Management to pick up on your regular garbage pickup day. Waste Management will pick up <u>one large item</u> a week in addition to your regular garbage.

- Foam cups & containers
- Needles

Holiday Refuse & Recycling Pick Up will be one day later than your regular pickup day **AFTER THE HOLIDAY.** Monday & Tuesday pick up is not changed.



Outdoor Safety

- If you can hear thunder, you are within distance of lightning. Look for Shelter inside a home, large building, or a hard - topped vehicle right away. Do not go under tall trees for shelter. There is no place outside that is safe during a thunderstorm. Wait at least 30 mins. After the last thunder before leaving your shelter
- Stay away from windows and doors.
- If you are in or on open water, go to land and seek shelter immediately.
- If you feel your hair stand on end, that means lightning is about to strike, squat low to the ground on the balls of your feet. Place your hands over your ears and your head between your knees. Make yourself the smallest target possible and minimize your contact with ground.

If a person is struck by lightning, call 9-1-1 and get medical care immediately. Lightning strike victims carry no electrical charge; attend to them immediately. Check their breathing, heartbeat, and pulse. CPR may be needed.

Indoor Safety

- Unplug appliances and other electrical items, like computers, and turn off air conditioners. If you are unable to unplug them, turn them off.
- Stay off corded phones, computers, and other electronic equipment that put you in direct contact with electricity or plumbing. Avoid washing your hands, bathing, doing laundry, or washing dishes.
