It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Munster's first Police K9, Django. Django passed away on 2/27/2019

after a short, hard battle with cancer. Django was put into service in 2012 as a dual-purpose narcotics detection canine. He served faithfully alongside his handler, Officer Brian Hernandez, for six years before being diagnosed with cancer. Django was a huge part of our department and will be missed by all of us.

When we began our K9 program in 2012, we did so exclusively through grants and funds donated by residents and local businesses. Thanks to the community's tremendous support the K9 program is funded solely from donations. We are extremely grateful to have such strong community support in order to make our K9 program possible. In 2018 we announced plans to expand our K9 program and began a fundraising campaign to add a comfort/narcotics K9 to the department. The residents and community have again responded extraordinarily with their support and donations. The new K9 will be put into service this year and will be trained as a comfort dog to aid with victims of crime and abuse and in narcotics detection.

With the recent passing of Django, we are once again seeking the community's support as we hope to add another patrol K9 to the department. LIGHTNING PREDICTION AND WARNING SYSTEM

The Thorguard Lightning Prediction Warning System will be reactivated in April at the following parks in town: Community Park, Beech Park, Ridgeway

Park, Frank H. Hammond Park, Stewart Park, White Oak Park, Twin Creek Park, Bluebird Park and Centennial Park. *NOTE*: The system will be operational 7 days a week from 6 am to 11 pm starting in April through November 31.

The warning system may be tested, on the first Wednesday of each month at 10 am. The Thorguard Lightning Prediction System will sound a warning horn (15 second blast) when a potentially dangerous weather situation is approaching. If you hear the alarm, clear the park immediately and seek proper shelter. All activities must cease once you hear the horn. Wait for the all clear (3 short horn blasts), before returning to normal activities. If the all clear does not sound after 30 minutes, cancel your park event. This system is here for your safety.

SPRING LEAF COLLECTION

Starting April 1, 2019 weather permitting for 2 weeks. Munster will be having the spring leaf collection. Do not put leaves in your garbage can, plastic bags or in brown bags, Waste Management will not pick them up.

Rake your leaves to the curb for the spring leaf collection. Since pick-up quantities are not known, it is difficult to predict exactly which neighborhood will be picked up on which day, so please have your leaves out on Monday. We will start on the northwest section of Town and work south. Please place your leaves in a continuous long pile. We will be using a leaf vacuum to collect your leaves. If your street has curbs, please place your leaves right behind the curb on the grass parkway. PLEASE DO NOT PLACE LEAVES IN THE STREET. If your street does not have curbs, please place your leaves on the edge of the street pavement. Also, please be careful not to mix leaves with large sticks, rocks or other debris, which could cause injury to an employee or damage to the equipment. Thank you for your cooperation. DRAIN GRATES April showers bring more than May flowers. Spring rains can cause flooding of yards and streets. Most of the time flooding can be prevented by making sure the drain grates are kept free of debris. It doesn't take much to clog a drain and have it cause

significant flooding of streets and/or yards. As material such as leaves, twigs, and litter are washed from the ground surface it collects onto the drain grating and acts like a rubber plug. The flow of water runoff into the drainage system is drastically reduced when material collects near or on the drain grate. Residents can do their part by helping keep drains near your home free of debris.



BRANCH COLLECTION

Starting April 1, 2019 weather permitting; branches will be picked up with the chipper. These branches should be no longer than 5' long and 3" in

diameter. Twigs and yard waste should be put into your garbage cans or bagged. Small branches should be bundled and tied; these will be picked up with your garbage. If you have any questions, you can contact the Public Works Department at 836-6971.
