

COMMUNITY NEWS The Dog Days of Summer I thought I would share a little

information about Munster Pet Licenses. The Town of Munster code requires registration

for each of your pet dogs and cats. The license is available all year round through the Clerk-Treasurer's (CT) office. If you have put off getting your 2021 license, we can still get you registered. Annual renewals are available beginning each December. Registration forms are online and in the CT office. You will need a copy of your pet's vaccination certificate, rabies certification number, and a \$10 fee for each pet. In 2020, we collected \$5,720 in miscellaneous revenue from issuing pet licenses. The money helps to support the Code Enforcement Officer, who handles stray animals and animals at large.

Go Green Option Many residents asked for paperless utility bills, and we are able to do that for you. You have been receiving your invoice either in the mail or electronically. If you are happy with your bill's current delivery method, do nothing, we will not be changing it for you. If you are interested in receiving your utility bill with a link to News You Can Use, contact me at wmis@munster.org, and we will get you set up with paperless invoices.

Payment Choices The Town will not be changing to only online payments. We continue to offer our residents various payment methods, and you can select which method works best for you. We do accept payment in the Clerk-Treasurer's office with cash, checks, or credit cards. The mail and our Red Drop Box are acceptable methods for sending checks. Additionally, we encourage residents to enroll in ACH autopayment through the Town. If you are already enrolled in ACH, do nothing; you are already set up for timely payment. Payments arranged directly through our office, whether in person, drop box, mail, or ACH, will not be subject to a convenience fee. Whether your invoice was delivered electronically or via the mail, you are able to pay your invoice online. The Town's authorized payment provider, Invoice Cloud, does allow for both one-time and autopay scheduled payments. There will be a convenience fee for only payments made online through Invoice Cloud.

These new changes have caused some confusion with a few of our residents, and we appreciate your questions. We encourage your feedback and suggestions for the betterment of Munster. MUNSTER'S NATIONAL NIGHT OUT AGAINST CRIME CELEBRATION TUESDAY, AUGUST 3RD

The Munster Police Department and Choice Community Council of Munster invite and encourage all residents to participate in Munster's 26th Annual National Night Out Against Crime Celebration, which will be held on Tuesday, August 3, 2021 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at the Munster Community Pool located at 8837 Calumet Avenue. This fun and exiting event is held annually to promote positive police and community partnerships through a variety of both educational activities and fun for all ages.

The Main Event will be preceded at 4:30 p.m. with our National Night Out Community Parade which will run from the corner of Park Drive and Columbia Avenue south on Columbia Avenue to the south lot of Munster High School. The parade will include emergency vehicles, school groups, community organizations, and more. Residents are encouraged to line Columbia Avenue to show your support for our event and then you can walk directly over to our main event at the pool.

The Main National Night Out Event will begin at 5:00 p.m. at the Munster Community Pool with a performance of the National Anthem. The event's activities will include free swimming for Munster residents (please show state or school ID), door prizes, kids games, emergency vehicles, K-9 demonstrations, a police helicopter landing, over 75 booth participants. Also included in event is The John Meisner Magic Show, a video gaming van, food vendors, music, free child identification cards, crime prevention information, Citizenship Award presentations, special guests (including ESPN 1000 radio personality John "Jurko" Jurkovic, former NFL player Tim Tyrrell, and former NFL coach Angel Lopez), musical performances, barrel car train rides, blood drive (see further below for more info), free glow necklaces for kids, and an awesome closing Fireworks Show generously sponsored by Krazy Kaplan's Fireworks.

The American Red Cross will set up on-site prior to the start of the event and will be running a blood drive throughout the evening from 2:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Walkups are welcome, however, you can pre-register your blood donation by calling 1-800-RED-CROSS or entering the sponsor code "mcpool".


PREVENTING DISTRACTION SCAMS & THEFTS

Since June 10th, the Munster Police Department has responded to several calls for service in reference to reported distraction scams and thefts. During these incidents, male suspects reportedly identified themselves as either being from the water department, needing to check the home's water system, or advising that they had work to do in their backyard. While the victim was being distracted in a back room of the home or in the backyard, a second suspect enters the home to steal items. No one was injured during these incidents.

Residents should stay alert for these types of scams which usually target senior citizens and involve suspects pretending to be utility workers or town officials who are investigating an emergency situation involving the resident's water or power supply. These suspects will often wear hard hats, reflective vests, or false identification to make them appear to be legitimate utility workers and will also carry two-way portable radios at times to communicate with an accomplice.

Residents are encouraged to always keep their exterior doors closed and locked at all times, including storm doors when present, and to speak with unknown visitors through a side window. Residents should also keep overhead garage doors closed and locked, especially if you have a connecting garage, and carry a key and cell phone with you while working outside so that you can keep your home secured and report suspicious activity when necessary.

PLEASE CALL 911 to report suspicious individuals on your property right away and never allow strangers into your home who you did not call personally for home service or repairs.
