

**TOWN OF MUNSTER
MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE
REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION
AUGUST 1, 2022**

A regular meeting of the Munster Redevelopment Commission convened at 7:35 p.m. on Monday, August 1, 2022. Ordinance 1830 is the basis for holding electronic meetings. The announced meeting location was Munster Town Hall. Councilors, Staff, and the public had the option to participate via Zoom meeting technology.

Commissioners Chuck Gardiner, Andy Koulourides, Lee Ann Mellon, Ken Schoon, Steven Tulowitzki were physically present in Town Hall and School Town of Munster Representative John Castro was present virtually. President Gardiner presided.
