

**TOWN OF MUNSTER
MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION
SEPTEMBER 6, 2022**

A special meeting of the Munster Redevelopment Commission convened at 7:33 p.m. on Tuesday, September 6, 2022. Ordinance 1830 is the basis for holding electronic meetings. The announced meeting location was Munster Town Hall. Councilors, Staff, and the public had the option to participate via Zoom meeting technology.

Commissioners Chuck Gardiner, Andy Koultourides, Lee Ann Mellon, Ken Schoon, and Steven Tulowitzki were physically present in Town Hall. School Town of Munster Representative John Castro was absent. President Gardiner presided.

Also present in Town Hall were Executive Secretary Wendy Mis, Controller Patricia Abbott, Executive Director Dustin Anderson, Deputy Town Manager Jill DiTommaso, Attorney David W.
