In addition to some youth programs at the Munster Library, we wanted to let you know that this summer there will be additional events and activities to continue our celebration of being a Monarch City. Residents are asked to take pictures of their home gardens for an August/September Library Exhibit through the month of July. Monarch Fest will be held at Heritage Park on Sunday, September 10th.

Finally, if you see common milkweed around town, please leave it be. We need 130 million stems of common milkweed by 2038 to save this magnificent butterfly and its migration. As part of this year's National Night Out Week events, the Munster Police Department invites all residents to participate in the 2023 National Night Out Block Party Contest. The purpose

of the contest is to encourage neighborhood unity and to raise awareness about the National Night Out Against Crime Celebration. The block parties will be held on Saturday, July 29th.

SCHOOL TOWN OF MUNSTER KINDERGARTEN ROUND-UP

IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO REGISTER FOR KINDERGARTEN, A CHILD MUST BE FIVE YEARS OLD ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 1, 2023.

Families will need to complete the following:

- 1. Kindergarten Enrollment Form
- 2. Registration Gateway
- 3. After completing Registration Gateway, please contact your child's school for instructions on how to complete the registration process.

At the time of the scheduled enrollment with your child's school, parents must provide ALL of the following:

Enrollment Documents

- certified/original birth certificate of the child, updated immunization records, a valid driver's license with current Munster address (baptismal and hospital records are not acceptable as proof of birth)
- Updated immunization records
- A valid driver's license with current Munster address

Residency Documents:

- If homeowner, a mortgage statement, settlement statement or property tax receipt containing the names of the homeowners OR two additional items from the list below: if renter, a lease (MUST be current) indicating the term of the lease, address of the property, name and phone number of the lessor, name of the lessee and a listing of tenants
- Two additional items from list—Town of Munster Water Bill, NIPSCO Bill, Auto Insurance Bill, Bank Statements, Telephone Bill, Pay Stub with Current Address



ELECTRONIC RECYCLING SHED

The Electronic Recycling shed has been moved inside the Public Works Facility fence at 508 Fisher Street. Access to the Electronic Recycling Shed is Monday through Friday from 7:00 am - 3:00 pm during the operating hours of Public Works. There is not an attendant to assist with unloading. Electronic Recycling is available to Lake County, Indiana residents. It is not available for businesses or non-profit organizations.

BRANCH COLLECTION

Branches should be no longer than 7' long and 5" in diameter. Twigs and yard waste should be put into your garbage cans or bagged. Small branches should be bundled and tied; these will be picked up with your garbage. If you have any questions, you can contact the Public Works Department at (219)836-6971.
