

MUNSTER COMMUNITY POOL



General Information

Munster Community Pool is a zero depth entry pool with water features and slides, lounge chairs, grassy areas, shelter facility and full service concession area. We also offer changing areas, showers, lockers, family rest areas and life jackets.

Age 2 and under are free with a paid adult. Youth 16 and under must be accompanied by a paid adult. To receive the resident rate, Munster and Highland residents must show ID. Students will be asked for their student ID.

Bathing Attire

Bathing suits are required for swimming in Munster Community Pool. Shorts and athletic wear are not considered acceptable bathing attire. If you do not have proper swim attire you can make a purchase through our selection at the Admission counter.

Flotation Devices

Flotation devices (i.e. life rings, noodles, inflatable tubes) are not allowed. Only coast guard approved life vests (no suits with built-in flotation) are allowed. We offer complementary use of life vests to our pool patrons thanks to a generous donation from Munster **Community Healthcare System**. Life vests can be checked out at the pool in exchange for your ID.

Season Passes

Purchase a season pass at the discounted "Early Bird" rate prior to the pool opening day! **Don't delay the discount ends on May 10.** Season pass holders will be given a card to submit upon each entry to the Munster Pool. Photos will be required upon purchase. Children 16 and younger must be accompanied by a paid adult.

Season Pass Requirements

- To be considered a "resident", one must possess a current driver's license or State ID showing Munster or Highland residency. No exceptions.
- A family is identified as a parent(s) and/or any unmarried children who are living at a single address.



- 3. Adult children must show proof of residency. Other relatives, may not be included on the family membership.
- 4. Passes are per individual and cannot be shared.
- 5. Passes will not be printed until photos have been taken.
- 6. Must be present at time of purchase and provide ID (restrictions apply).

FREE to season pass holders only, during the regular season (ends 8/11/2024). Must be at least 18 years old. Present your pass at the gate. Pass Holders will be required to exit the gates after open swim ends and reenter for the day should they wish to stay. You **may not** leave your belongings in the pool to save chairs. *Please be aware that private lessons could be scheduled during this time. If private lessons occur, we will make every attempt to inform you in advance.

Policies and Procedures

- Minimum group size fifteen (15) people.
- One adult chaperone per 10 children admitted free.
- Chaperone's must be in the pool with children at all times.
- If crowded, groups may not use lawn chairs.
- No food or drink may be brought into the facility.
- Groups must be booked at least 3 days in advance with the Superintendent of Recreation. No on-site groups will be taken.

Join us after regular pool hours and host your very own private pool party. A great place for family reunions, corporate parties, birthdays and graduations. Parties will begin 30 minutes after pool closes.

A two-hour minimum is required for reservations.

If you require concessions to remain open for your rental, a \$60 per hour fee will be charged for staffing.

Swim Lesson Descriptions

Parent/Tot 6 months to 3 years

Skills worked on in this level include: guided parent interaction, rolling over, getting child comfortable on front and back, kicks, arm movements, submersion, and blowing bubbles.

Preschool 3-5 years

Skills worked on in this level include: blowing bubbles, putting their face in the water, front and back floats, reach and pull for further stroke development, and simultaneous arm and leg motion.

Youth 6+ years

Allow our swim director to assign your child in a level that will meet and challenge their ability level to get them to be the best swimmer possible!

Dog Park Membership

Located in beautiful Centennial Park, this 3-acre dog park is a members-only park and offers dog-sized drinking fountains, a dog playground, shelters, fenced in security, a hilltop view, and dog doo doo bags. Users pay an annual fee to offset the care and maintenance of the dog park. Proof of immunization must be submitted for all dogs before a pass is issued. Immunization records must include up-to-date rabies, bordatella and distemper shots. There is a three-dog limit. A lanyard and identification card will be issued and must be worn at all times when using the dog park. This is an annual membership beginning on date of purchase. Centennial Park has established a pay-to-park system. Included with your dog park membership is a calendar year parking permit for one vehicle via registered license plate. Otherwise pay-to-park rates are \$2 per hour or \$5 per day.

When planning your outdoor events consider Centennial Park. Beautiful landscaping, walking paths, wooden boardwalks, steel trussed bridge, entertainment stage, formal gardens and Maynard Lake with scenic views is the perfect setting for your outdoor wedding ceremonies and photographs.

The Formal Gardens are adjacent to one another on the east side of the park. The gardens are arranged with beautiful floral settings which include: roses, ornamental grasses, flowering shrubs, perennials and annuals and are landscaped with large rocks. Each garden has an entrance arbor with a shade pergola and is enclosed with a white picket fence.

The Outdoor Entertainment Stage sits on the edge of Maynard Lake and overlooks a beautifully landscaped tiered seating area for up to 2000 people. Beautiful walking paths, wooden boardwalks and a steel trussed bridge surround the lake with scenic views. *Entertainment Stage does not include any chairs. Bench seating is available.

Included with your wedding ceremony rental is a QR Code for your guests to park at Centennial Park without having to pay. Otherwise pay-to-park rates are \$2 per hour or \$5 per day.

Larger/all-day events must be approved by the Director of Parks and Recreation and will be subject to additional fees including staff, set-up, garbage removal, electric, porta potties, etc. based on the size and length of the event and will be payable at time of rental.

Heritage Park Gazebo

Munster Bike Paths

Munster is proud to offer eleven miles of continuous bike paths. The paths connect communities along the Indiana and Illinois state line, linking residential neighborhoods, industrial and office parks, shopping areas, forest preserves, and green-ways. The areas designated as bike paths may be used for biking, rollerskating, roller blading, walking, jogging, and other personal recreational activities.



Listed below are the Town of Munster Ordinances which should be observed by all park visitors to keep our parks beautiful and safe.

- » Parks are open dawn to dusk, except for Centennial Park which is open until 10:00 pm.
- » Alcoholic beverages and glass containers are prohibited.
- » Dogs must be on a leash and owners must clean up after their pets.
- » Unauthorized use of the dog park at Centennial Park will result in a fine to all parties liable.
- No go-karts, mopeds, or any other motor driven vehicles shall be operated in any of the parks.
- Golfing is prohibited except at Centennial Park. Wiffleball golf is allowed as long as divots are replaced.
- » Camping is not allowed in any of the parks.
- » Open burning and fireworks are prohibited in any park.
- » No skateboards or roller blades allowed on the park courts or stage.
- » The moving or relocating of soccer goals in the parks is not permitted without prior approval and will result in a fine.
- » Groups of 15 or more must obtain a permit to use the park shelters.
- » Grilling is prohibited.
- » No smoking within 15 feet of entryways or public spaces outdoors.
- » Commercial enterprises conducting business, sales of concessions, and food trucks are prohibited.

Lightning Warning System

Munster Parks and Recreation uses a lightning warning system in our parks. The signal is activated by threatening weather. You will hear an audible siren horn and see a flashing light on top of the device (typically located on shelter roofs) in the park. When the warning signal activates, all patrons must SEEK SHELTER IMMEDIATELY. Once you hear three horn signals, park activities can resume. This system is not fail-proof. Take shelter immediately when lightning threatens even if a signal has not sounded.

Active between April 1 and Nov. 30 annually.

Refund Policy

Munster Parks and Recreation is committed to providing the highest quality recreation activities, events, and programs. If a person is not completely satisfied with a program due to circumstances under the department's control, Munster Parks and Recreation will arrange for the person to participate in a similar class or obtain a credit to their Park account to use for future programming.

A credit to your Park account will be granted:

- If a participant is dissatisfied with a Munster Parks and Recreation class, program or activity due to circumstances under the department's control. Credit requests must be made prior to the midpoint of the class, program or activity to the direct supervisor.
- 2. On trips or shows if the seat can be resold.

A full refund will be granted:

- If the refund is initiated by Munster Parks and Recreation (i.e. canceled class or low enrollment), minus Online credit card fees.
- For injury or illness, with a doctor's note.
 If an injury or illness happens during the
 program, only a prorated fee would be
 refunded or credited to your Park account.

All other refunds (unless otherwise noted):

- Credits to your Park account will be issued prior to the program start date as long as enrollment is greater than minimum to run. You are able to use this credit for future programs, rentals or memberships where payment is made payable to Town of Munster.
- Refunds will not be granted for: schedule conflicts, vacations, special events, trips, unused gift certificates, field reservations, facility rental fees, summer camp, Munster Pool season passes, dog park membership or any other reason beyond our department's control.
- 3. Refunds are processed weekly on Monday and checks are mailed on Thursday. You will receive your refund check within 5-10 business days.
- 4. All refunds will be issued by check. We are unable to process refunds to a credit card.
