Let's go Paperless



The Town of Munster offers a paperless billing option, if you like it in the mail, we are not requiring you to change. email your Town of Munster utility bill, a link to the current News You Can Use and

other relevant information to you. The first email often arrives days before the paper invoice would hit your mailbox, a second reminder of emails is sent out about 10 days before the bill is due and rarely, a third email may be sent if the due date timing and the autopay dates are over a weekend or holiday. Munster Parks, Public Art, and Methane Gas



The Park Director, Mark Heintz, and I recently gave a presentation to the Munster Garden Club about our parks and public art. The meeting has been featured on the GreatNews.Life website and Facebook page.

The Centennial Park property has a rich history. It is a 200 acre park that was

originally the site of the National Brick Company. The property eventually became the town landfill, with plans for ball diamonds and picnic areas once it closed. However, the flat land required for those plans was inconsistent with the needs of a closed landfill site. As a result, the hills evolved into the beautiful golf course we now enjoy.

Closed landfills produce methane gas, which many landfills burn off, resulting in an unpleasant smell. To address this issue, we installed a generator on the southern edge of the park to capture methane gas naturally produced from decomposing organic material in the landfill. This helps Munster reduce our carbon footprint and provides an opportunity to turn waste into a resource. Instead of allowing the methane to escape into the atmosphere, the generator captures and converts the gas into energy. We sell the generated energy, using the revenue to offset the power needs of Centennial Park. The original generator is reaching the end of its useful life. In 2025, we plan to install a newer and more efficient generator. We believe this new generator will continue to generate energy and revenue for many years to come.

Burning shall be in a non-combustible container that is sufficiently vented and has enclosed sides and bottom. Only clean wood can be burned (no painted wood, trash etc.). The fire shall be extinguished if it creates a nuisance, fire hazard or pollution problem. No burning shall be conducted during unfavorable meteorological conditions such as high winds, temperature inversions, air stagnation, when there is a pollution alert, ozone action days or during a Red Flag warning. Burning should be at least 10 feet away from any structure.

- Spring Leaf Collection ended in April.
- Garbage and Recycling will be delayed one day, Monday May 27, 2024, in observance of Memorial Day.
- Public Works offers free wood chips on the first Saturday of the month, 8 am Noon, May through October. Bring your own shovel and something to put the wood chips in.
- Branch Collection: Branches should be no longer than 7' long and 5" in diameter. Twigs and yard waste should be put into your garbage cans or bagged. 


All Collections from 9 am - 2 pm. Loads are limited to 100 pounds and Latex Paint is no longer accepted at these collections.
