Thursday, July 20, 2023
7:00 a.m.
Munster Town Hall Main Meeting Room

This meeting was held in person at the Munster Town Hall and via Zoom.

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Dr. Lorin Brown at 7:03 a.m. Other members present: Dr. Robert Dershewitz and Linda Dunn.

Others present: Chief of Police Stephen Scheckel, Lieutenant Daymon Johnston, Administrative Assistant to the Chief of Police Nancy Nadratowski, Fire Chief Mark Hajduk, Town Council President Chuck Gardiner (via Zoom), Town Attorney David Westland, Clerk Treasurer Wendy Mis, Clerk Treasurer Personnel Patricia Abbott, Superior Ambulance Personnel Jeff Collins, Dave Faber, Jan Cox, and Armani Porter.

Pledge of Allegiance

Public Comment: Ms. Chris Pleitner of 8517 Forrest expressed her concerns to the Board regarding speeding vehicles in her area. She came before the Board originally in July of 2022 and she requested an update as they are still experiencing issues. Chief Scheckel stated the Town has created a Speed Committee which addresses speeding concerns throughout town. Directed Patrols were conducted and speed rate signs were deployed in 2022 after Ms. Pleitner addressed the Board. Suggestions such as speed bumps and roundabouts have been discussed. Chief Scheckel encouraged Ms. Pleitner to contact the Town Manager's Office to speak to the Assistant Town Manager as she heads the committee. If Ms. Pleitner can get plate numbers, the Police Department can contact those drivers. Dr. Brown also suggested she contact Officer Ghrist about being a block captain.

Ms. Dunn inquired if the hydrant painting was complete. Chief Hajduk stated that they are about two-thirds done, the rest will be completed next year.

Dr. Dershewitz noted that response times are not included in the Fire Department's monthly reports, would that be something that should be tracked or prove useful? Chief Hajduk stated that it was up to the Board if they want it to be included. They do keep a record of response times and the department does meet the standards established by the NFPA. The department's policy states a maximum of sixty (60) firefighters, who need to respond to 20% of the calls within nine minutes. The department's response times are the best in the area for

part-time, on-call status. A new program went into effect two (2) days ago which will alert firefighters to a fire call coming in, prior to it being dispatched.

Dr. Dershewitz motioned to accept the Consent Agenda items. Ms. Dunn seconded the motion. All members present voted aye by roll call vote, motion approved 3-0.

III. Items for Action & Discussion

Ms. Dunn stated it was a good month for Superior. Average response time was 2.59 minutes and 3.58 to patient's side. All questions were answered satisfactorily.

Ms. Dunn motioned to accept the Superior Ambulance report. Dr. Dershewitz seconded the motion. All members present voted aye by roll call vote, motion approved 3-0.

IV. Fire Chief's Report

Chief Hajduk informed the Board the department was awarded a \$10,000.00 grant from the Indiana Department of Homeland Security for a baby box, which will be installed at Fire Station #2. Deadline for installation and training is July 2024. Mr. Westland asked to review the contract for the baby box, through Save Haven, once it is received. Next month the new fire apparatus will be in hopefully.

V. Police Chief's Report

Chief Scheckel asked the Board to consider giving the department approval to get another K-9. Currently the department has two (2) dual purpose dogs who are used for narcotics and as comfort dogs. Our third dog is a full-service K-9, and we would like to add another to allow the department more coverage. It will not cost the department any money as the program is paid through donations and Asset Forfeiture. The K-9 Unit recently had a successful Golf Outing to help raise funds for the donation account. Officer Serba will be the new dog's handler if approved. Our current provider does have a dog available.

Ms. Dunn motioned to authorize the Police Department to acquire another K-9 to be used for general police work. Dr. Dershewitz seconded the motion. All members present voted aye by roll call vote, motion approved 3-0.

VIII. Board's Comments

Ms. Dunn inquired if everything was ready for National Night Out? Chief Scheckel stated Officer Ghrist is ready and the event will be bigger and better than ever before. Currently have over twenty (20) block parties planned for the weekend prior and approximately a hundred vendors and participants for the night of. Dr. Brown asked if anyone wanted 50/50 tickets and or gun raffle tickets for the NISSA fundraiser to see him after the meeting. Next meeting date is Thursday, August 17, 2023.

IX. Adjournment

Ms. Dunn motioned to adjourn the meeting. Dr. Dershowitz seconded the motion. All members present voted aye, motion approved 3-0. Meeting was adjourned at 7:45 a.m.
