TRASH

Homewood Disposal Service (HDS) requests that you fill up the trash cart first before putting separate bags or cans next to your trash cart. The weight limit for each cart is 200 pounds.

Use the green cart with the green lid for trash. The trash will be picked once a week. Place your trash cart at the curb by 6 am the day of collection. After collection, all carts should be removed from the curb no later than the evening of your collection. Everything below should be put into your trash cart.

- Normal household garbage
- Yard Waste (grass clippings & garden clippings in or out of bags) NO TREE LEAVES
- Small Twigs

LARGE ITEMS

Homewood Disposal Service (HDS) will collect one (1) large/bulk item per week with your regular trash at no additional charge, resident will need to call HDS at 219-931-9000 to advise of the bulk item. Place your bulk item at the curb next to your trash cart. Examples of acceptable large items:

- Couches
- Chairs
- Household furniture
- Toilets
- Carpeting cut into 4-foot bundles and bound with electrical tape or rope
- Mattress and box spring

ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE PICKED UP BY HOMEWOOD DISPOSAL SERVICE

Leaves Explosive items Construction debris Landscaping debris Railroad ties **Bricks** Concrete Swing sets Glass Counter tops Cabinets Pesticides Roofing Oil based Paint Petroleum derivatives (motor oil, solvents) Electronics – Televisions, computers, laptops, phones, etc.

MISSED COLLECTION

Despite their best efforts, Homewood Disposal Service will occasionally miss scheduled collections. If they do, please call 219-931-9000. They will try to return on the same day to pick it up. If you failed to put your cart out in time, wait until next week's collection. Do not call Homewood Disposal Service as they cannot do special pickups in these instances. Garbage routes are televised to prevent any false claims.

BROKEN LID, BROKEN WHEEL, OR HOLE IN CART

If you have a broken lid, broken wheel or hole in your cart, call Homewood Disposal Service to get the cart repaired at 219-931-9000.

WHITE GOODS PICK UP

Homewood Disposal Service will pick up large appliances. Call 219-931-9000 to schedule pick up.

Garbage may also be placed in your own 32-gallon cans weighing no more than 50 lbs.
