MUNSTER'S FIREWORKS ORDINANCE



Munster's Fireworks Ordinance states that consumer fireworks may be discharged within the corporate limits of Munster from June 29th through July 3rd, and from July 5th through July 9th between the hours of 5 pm and two hours after sunset. On July 4th, fireworks can be discharged in between the hours of 10 pm and midnight.

Please note, however, that fireworks must be discharged on your own property (**not in the street or parks**) or on the property of someone who has given you permission. You must also be 18 years of age to possess or discharge fireworks unless accompanied by a supervising adult. Please be safe and respectful of your neighbors (and their properties) when discharging fireworks.

Violators of this ordinance can be fined by the Munster Police Department.

CHARGE PILES

The Town of Munster charges a fee for collection of large amounts of garbage, debris and/or yard waste. When the Street Department determines a collection would be excessive, a letter is left on your door. The minimum collection fee is \$130. MOSQUITO CONTROL

Mosquitoes are an all too familiar summer nuisance. They are not only annoying, but they can be transmitters of west Nile virus, encephalitis, malaria and yellow fever to humans and virus and heartworms to pets. The Town of Munster is using the safest mosquito products available to control mosquitoes. Mosquito briquettes will be placed in all areas where there is standing water to kill the mosquitoes before they hatch. Mosquito spraying will be done to kill the adult population of mosquitoes. Spraying is usually done in the evening hours between 10 pm and 7 am when weather conditions fall into a favorable pattern. The pesticide used has no odor and is harmless to humans and pets.

You can take simple, positive steps to reduce this menace right at home, since many generations of mosquitoes can breed right in your own yard.

- Get rid of old tires, tin cans, buckets, drums, bottles or any water holding containers.
- Fill in or drain any low places (puddles, ruts) in yard.
- Keep drains, ditches and culverts clean of weeds and trash so water will drain properly.
- Cover trash containers to keep out rain water.
- Repair leaky pipes and outside faucets.
- Empty plastic wading pools at least once a week and store it indoors when not in use.
- Make sure your backyard pool is properly cared for while on vacation.
- Fill in tree rot holes and hollow stumps that hold water with sand or concrete.
- Change the water in bird baths and plant pots or drip trays at least once each week.
- Keep grass cut short and shrubbery well trimmed around the house so adult mosquitoes will not hide there.

The residents of Munster should take precautions for themselves and their children when they go out in areas where they may become exposed to mosquitoes.

What you can do to reduce your risk of being bitten by mosquitoes.

- Stay indoors at dawn, dusk and in the early evening.
- Wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants whenever you are outdoors.
- Spray clothing with repellents containing permethrin or DEET since mosquitoes may bite through the clothing.
- Apply insect repellent sparingly to exposed skin. An effective repellent will contain 35% DEET. Deet in high concentrations (greater than 35%) provides no additional protection.
- Repellents may irritate the eyes and mouth, so avoid applying repellent to the hands of children.
- Whenever you use insecticide or insect repellent, be sure to read and follow the manufacturer's DIRECTIONS FOR USE, as printed on the product.

WHITE GOODS

The town will pick up white goods on Wednesdays. White goods are washers, dryers, refrigerators, freezers, dishwashers, microwaves and hot water heaters. WOOD CHIPS

Town of Munster residents can pick up free wood chips at the Public Works Garage, 508 Fisher Street, Monday thru Friday, 7:30 am to 2:30 pm. Free wood chips are also available for pick up on the first Saturday of the month, starting in June through September, between the hours of 8:00 am to 12:00 noon. It is the responsibility of the resident to transport their own wood chips. You will be required to show proof of residency. Three Things to Know About Paying Your Water Bill with Online Bill Pay Through Your Bank

Do you pay through online bill pay with your bank? The following are three important facts to keep in mind.

1. We receive many payments with incorrect or incomplete water account numbers. Please check the account number you have listed. Your water account number is nine digits and is formatted like this 0000000-00. The number can be found in several places on your billing statement.
2. Although you're paying "online," your bank sends us an actual, paper check through the United States mail not through electronic means. Our recent experience with mail delivery times leads us to recommend allowing at least 10 days for mail time. We are not responsible for mail delays and late fees will be assessed.
3. Your monthly water bill amount fluctuates based on your usage. Be sure to confirm the amount of your bill each month. If you have set up a repeating payment with your bank and it does not cover the bill for that month, late fees will be added.

Does this sound like too much of a hassle? Sign up for ACH which automatically withdraws the exact amount due each month on the due date. Go to www.munster.org and search on "ach" for the sign-up form.
