#### **MUNSTER'S FIREWORKS ORDINANCE**



JEWS YOU CAN USE

Munster's Fireworks Ordinance states that consumer fireworks may be discharged within the corporate limits of Munster from June 29th through July 3rd, and from July 5th through July 9th between the hours of 5 pm

and two hours after sunset. On July 4th, fireworks can be discharged in between the hours of 10 pm and midnight.

Please note, however, that fireworks must be discharged on your own property (**not in the street or parks**) or on the property of someone who has given you permission. You must also be 18 years of age to possess or discharge fireworks unless accompanied by a supervising adult. Please be safe and respectful of your neighbors (and their properties) when discharging fireworks.

Violators of this ordinance can be fined by the Munster Police Department.

#### HOW TO DISPOSE OF .....

- **Computers and Electronics** The Munster Public Works Department has a recycling shed for electronics at the Public Works Garage, 508 Fisher Street, in the recycling area to the right of their driveway. The shed is accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. There is no attendant on sight to help unload the computers and electronics.
- Latex Paint latex paint can be put into your regular garbage IF IT IS COMPLETELY DRY. You will need to take the top off and put either kitty litter or sand into the paint and let it sit out for a couple of days to dry up. Once it is dried out, you can place it in the garbage. If it is not dry, once the hopper compresses on the garbage truck, you will have paint down your street. PLEASE MAKE SURE IT IS COMPLETELY DRY.
- You can also take latex paint for recycling to the City of Hobart Yard, 340 S. Shelby Street, Hobart. Drop off days will be Monday – Friday 7 am to 2:45 pm, Saturdays 8 am to 11:45 am. **No oil based paint will be accepted.** Any questions please call Hobart City Yard at 219-942-6121.
- Oil Based Paint and Solvents you will need to take these items to a household hazardous waste pick up. Munster's Household Hazardous Waste pick up will be Saturday, September 19th, 9 am to 2 pm at the Public Works Garage, 508 Fisher Street.
- **Carpet** Waste Management will pick up carpet that is cut into 5 foot lengths, rolled and bound. It can be bound with electrical tape or string and put out on your normal pick up day. If the carpet is not bound, it will not be picked up.
- Large Items (Sofas, Household Furniture, Carpeting, Bicycles, Mattresses, Etc.) – Waste Management will pick up ONE large item a week with your normal garbage, you do <u>not</u> need to call in for the pick up.

#### AUTOMATIC PAYMENT FOR YOUR WATER BILL

OOPS! Forgetting to pay your water bill can happen to anyone. But, did you know you never have to worry about forgetting again? Just sign up for Automated Clearing House or ACH. Your water bill will be AUTOMATICALLY paid through your checking or savings account. It's a safe and convenient way to pay your water bill. You will still receive your statement in the mail every month. The remittance stub will say DO NOT PAY – ACH PULL (DUE DATE). You can see the exact amount and date that amount will be debited from your account. Nothing to mail, nothing to submit and no worries. We have included the form for you to complete in this issue of the News You Can Use. Be sure to fill it out legibly. Either attach a voided check or completely fill out the top section of the form. Then complete the highlighted fields and send it to us. You can mail it or drop it in the blue drop box in the Town Hall parking lot. You should still pay one more bill manually to allow time for the banks to verify the account numbers.

#### CONTACT INFORMATION

If you have cancelled your land line, please be sure we have your cell phone numbers on file. Occasionally we may need to contact our customers for various reasons. The most common reason is that we notice your usage is up and we would like to discuss that with you. Please let us know the best number to reach you should there be an issue to discuss with you. #### **MOVING?**

If you are planning a move, please be sure to call the Water Billing office at least one business day before closing to schedule a final reading so we can prepare a final bill for you. Your regular monthly bills are for the previous month's usage and the final bill brings your account to the current date and reading.
