

REFLECTIVE TRICK-OR-TREATING BAGS

To promote visibility for some area children this Halloween, the Choice Community Council of Munster has purchased several hundred reflective Halloween trick-or-treating bags that will be available for pick-up at the town's public elementary schools or at the Records window of the Munster Police Department (during regular business hours) **beginning Monday, October 10th and until they are gone.** Visit the main office of your child's school or the police department's Records window and pick up the bag from the front counter. The secretaries will be notified once the bags have run out.

HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS

The Munster Police Department encourages parents to share the following safety tips with their children as Halloween approaches:

- Only trick-or-treat at well-lit homes, and in familiar neighborhoods.
- Tell children not to accept or eat anything that isn't commerciallywrapped, and check all of their candy before you allow them to consume it.
- Make sure that masks fit securely and that they allow for adequate vision and ventilation. Wear well-fitting costumes and shoes to avoid trips and falls.
- Add reflective tape to your child's costume or bag to make them more visible.
- Warn your children not to run across streets and not to go into anyone's homes. Always cross at well-lit intersections, and be on guard for oncoming vehicles.
- Make sure that your children are trick-or-treating in groups, that they stay together, and that an adult chaperone accompanies them.
- Talk with your children once again about stranger-danger, and encourage them to report anything suspicious to an adult immediately. Parents and chaperones are encouraged to bring their cell phone and a flashlight and to also report suspicious activity immediately by calling 911.

2016 FALL LEAF COLLECTION

LEAF COLLECTION PICK UP WILL BE ONCE EVERY 2 WEEKS

The Town of Munster 2016 Fall Leaf Collection will begin on Monday, October 3, 2016 and will continue through December 2, 2016, <u>weather</u> <u>permitting</u>. Leaves will be picked up between the hours of 7am to 2 pm, Monday through Friday. The Street Department crews will begin each day where they left off the previous day. LEAF COLLECTION WILL NO LONGER BE ONCE A WEEK. PICK UP WILL BE APPROXIMATELY ONCE EVERY TWO WEEKS. State Law prohibits disposal of leaves into landfills. Therefore, leaves in bags will not be picked up by the town or Waste Management.

Collection begins each morning promptly at 7am, please have your leaves ready for collection prior to that time. Due to the large area which must be covered each day, we will not be able to back-track into areas which have already been collected. The Town's leaf pickup route will be traveled approximately once every **2 weeks, weather permitting**. The following tips will help us continue to provide quality service:

- Place your leaves in a continuous long pile called a "WIND ROW". We will be using a leaf vacuum to collect your leaves.
- 2. If your street has curbs, place your leaves right behind the curb on the parkway grass. **Please do not place leaves in the street**. If it rains, these leaves could cover the street drains and cause unnecessary flooding.
- 3. If your street does not have curbs, place your leaves on the edge of the street pavement.
- 4. Please refrain from parking on the streets adjacent to piles of leaves between the hours of 7 am to 2 pm.
- 5. Do not place leaves around trees, sign posts, light or telephone poles.
- 6. Do not place sticks, bricks, stones or other materials in piles of leaves. High velocity equipment is used during our removal efforts and these items can do damage to equipment or more importantly, may injure an employee or bystander.

IMPORTANT: Leaves will not be picked up in bags. Please rake leaves to parkway.
