IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Two major unrelated projects have resulted in significant road closures this summer. Public Works has been notifying the public through the Town's **NIXLE** email & text public notification system. Construction along and closure of Columbia Avenue began in early June due to a Hammond Sanitary District (HSD) sanitary sewer force main replacement project along Columbia Avenue near the Hospital that later continued along Camellia Drive to Southwood Drive. The project was necessitated on an emergency basis due to the frequency of force main breaks that had occurred along Columbia Avenue during the past several months, suggesting a deteriorating sewer line requiring immediate attention. By July 20 this project should be completed by Grimmer Construction when it ties into the existing force main located near 45° Street and Southwood Drive and the existing pipe will be abandoned in place after the new pipe is tested and activated.

At about the same time as the HSD project started, plans were made by British Petroleum (BP) to replace a section of their petroleum pipeline under the Canadian National (CN) railroad tracks south of 45th Street near Columbia Avenue, that also runs under 45^{th} Street in line with the East side parkway of Columbia Avenue. A routine inspection identified this section of pipeline in need of repair and BP continues to monitor the line and has not seen any indication of a release from the pipeline. This project began on July 9 with the temporary closure of 45^{th} Street, Columbia Avenue (from 45^{th} Street to North of Camellia Drive), and Camellia Drive (from Columbia Avenue to Larch Drive). Traffic is being detoured via Fran Lin Parkway and Southwood Drive with appropriate road signs and all traffic signals surrounding these closures have been reoptimized for the new lane restrictions.

This **BP** project is expected to last around 6 weeks. **BP** has notified the immediate affected neighborhoods through door-to-door outreach before the project began. **BP**'s first task will be to locate conflicting utilities under 45th St and to determine if they can make necessary pipe cut and prep for new pipe insertion without need for a full road closure in an effort to minimize inconvenience to the motoring public. All construction vehicles (except while in route) will work within the confines of the closure zone.

Did you know that a common cause for unexplained water usage on your monthly bill is a toilet with a bad seal? It is important to know that you won't necessarily HEAR this type of leak. If you suspect an issue, you can add some food coloring to the tank (not the bowl). DO NOT FLUSH! After 15

- 20 minutes, if there is any food coloring in the bowl, you have a leak in the flapper at the bottom of the tank that is allowing water to seep through. Fixing that flapper will help keep your water costs down!
