WATER AND SEWER RATES TO INCREASE

The Town of Munster established fees for water consumption and for storm water runoff. These fees are used to manage the local water distribution system as well as the local storm water management system. Performing preventive maintenance,

repairing water main breaks, pond maintenance, and clearing catch basins are just a few examples of work that is done with these funds

The Town last revised our water rates in 2006 and storm water rates in 2004. Generally, utility rates should be adequate for three to five years. That the Town has kept rates unchanged for twelve to fourteen years is commendable, but the time has come for rates to be adjusted.

During the August 6, 2018 meeting of the Town Council, ordinances were adopted to increase water rates by an average of 6.7% and storm water rates an average of 47.58%. Although the increases may seem drastic, the accounting firm of Umbaugh & Associates studied the Town's rate structure and provided assurances that the increases are reasonable and necessary, especially in view of the long life of the previous rates. The new rates went into effect on August 15, 2018. Ratepayers will see the effects of the new rates on utility bills that will be due on October 22, 2018.

The Town Council understands that few people want to see utility bills increase. But most agree that the rate increases will allow for the responsible maintenance of our infrastructure, which will result in the delivery of clean water and efficient handling of storm water.

Navigating the Munster Code of Ordinances On-Line

The Community Development Department often receives calls with questions about property

regulations. While we are always happy to look these up for you, there is also another way for you to access this information anytime, as long as you have access to a computer. The entire Town of Munster Municipal Code of Ordinances can be found on our website. You can use this feature to look up an answer to a specific question or you can browse it to become more familiar with the current codes which include fire prevention and protection, property maintenance requirements, and the zoning ordinance.

To get to the on-line code of ordinances you will need to go to our website, www.munster.org. Once you are on our home page, click the "Municipal Code" box which is the second gray box from the left underneath the scrolling photos of the town. After clicking this box, you will be directed to the on-line code of ordinances, from here you have multiple options to look up an ordinance. You can also go directly to the on-line portal by entering this address into your search bar: https://library.municode.com/in/munster/codes/code_of_ordinances.

You can walk through the sections using the dropdowns on the left side or if you are looking for something specific you can enter a keyword into the "search" box located at the top of the page. This search feature will pull up a list of all the ordinances that include the keyword, this can be extremely useful if you do not know the specific chapter of the ordinance your question would fall under.

Once you find the information you are looking for, you have the ability to print directly from the site, download the file to your computer, or e-mail the ordinance by clicking on the corresponding blue symbol to the right of each section.

Learn. Be Aware. Fire can happen anywhere." During this week, firefighters visit the local schools to bring the prevention week theme and fire safety awareness to the students.

On Saturday, October 13th the Munster Fire Department will be hosting its annual Fire Prevention Week Open House. The event, which runs from 11 a.m. – 3:30 p.m., is free and open to the public. Fire Station No. 2, located at 550 Fisher Street, will host the event, as in years past. We encourage all residents of Munster and surrounding communities to attend and bring their families & friends. There is something to do for everyone. The Livable Munster: Character-Based Code project is now well underway. Thank you to the hundreds of people who attended the Planapalooza public charrette meetings in late July or completed our online survey. The goal of this project is to develop a zoning ordinance that reflects the vision of the people of Munster. So over the next few months, our consultants Town Planning and Urban Design Collaborative will take the information that we have gathered and use it to develop an initial draft of the Character Based Code. Our schedule calls for a release of the draft for public comment in early 2019.
