Can We See Your Address?? Help Us Find You!

Every home in Munster needs to have address numbers posted facing the addressed street. Address numbers should be at least 4" tall, 1/2" wide with a contrasting color to its background. If you have a home that has an alleyway, address numbers must be posted on the rear facing the alley. **See Munster**

Ordinance 26-2 and IFC 505.0. Clearly labeled addresses enable Emergency Responders to locate you as quickly as possible!

Munster Ordinance 26-2 & IFC 505.0 Building Numbering

(A) Every building and structure within the town shall bear a number to designate its location and address upon the street or property on which it fronts.

- (B) The number shall be that designated and determined by the building inspector of the town, and the number shall be determined and given to the owner upon issuance of a building permit.
- (C) The number constituting the address and location call be in accordance with the following standards:
 - (1) Arabic numerals shall be used.
 - (2) Each numeral shall be such a size that it is readily visible from the street.
 - (3) Each numeral shall be raised and clearly visible by line of sight from the abutting street or thoroughfare.
 - (4) The number shall be in a contrasting color tot hat of its background, i.e., a black number on a light-colored background or a white number on a dark-colored back ground.
 - (5) The number shall be at or about the main entrance of the building or structure.
 - (6) Where required by the *fire code official*, address numbers shall be provided in additional *approved* locations to facilitate emergency response.

- (7) Where access is by means of private road and the building cannot be viewed from the public way, a monument, pole or other sign or means shall be used to identify the structure.
- (D) At such as a building or structure is under roof, a temporary number shall be displayed. At or prior to the issuance of an occupancy permit, the permanent numbers shall displayed.

State Law Reference—Building numbering, IC 35-7-4-406(b).
