Re: Replacement of 2008 Greens Mower and 2008 Sprayer for Centennial Park Golf Course.

It has been discussed in the past that the entire fleet of Centennial Park Golf Course maintenance equipment is scheduled for replacement at the same time. After all, most of it was originally purchased together. Therefore, a plan was implemented in the repair and replacement schedule to stagger the replacements over several years to prevent this from happening in the future. This does come with the risk that most of the existing equipment will be used past its expected lifespan.

This year, the 11-year old Greens Mower and John Deere Course Sprayer are scheduled for replacement using Park Bond funds. Both are key pieces of the golf course fleet.

The following quotes were received for the Greens Mower:

Budget: \$30,000

The Reindeers Toro Greenmaster Triflex 3300 is very slightly over budget. However, it is the best option because the reels are interchangeable with other machines in the fleet, causing very little downtime in the event of a breakdown. Plus, it provides a better cut quality than the other options. Plus, the JW turf model does not meet the specifications that were requested.

Recommendation 1

It is recommended that the Park Board authorize the purchase of the Toro Greenmaster Triflex 3300 from Reindeers Equipment in the amount of \$30,429.37.
