YARD WASTE

Yard waste is dead flowers and plants including pine needles and pine cones. These items should be put in your garbage can or bagged.

LEAVES are not considered Yard Waste. You **cannot** put leaves in the garbage, Waste Management will not pick them up. Small piles of branches should either be put in the garbage can or bundled/ tied and set next to the garbage can, these will be picked up by Waste Management.
