#### From the Clerk-Treasurer:


Town Hall has been closed to the public, and residents have adapted to the new normal. Residents are mailing in utility payments, paying online or depositing payments in the red drop box instead of coming into the building. We have seen a significant increase in people signing up for ACH or direct withdrawals as a method of payment. If you are enrolled in ACH payments, you will still get a printed water bill in the News You Can Use at the beginning of the month. Your monthly payment will automatically be debited from the authorized account on the payment due date. For your convenience, an authorization form has been included in this newsletter. For those who have recently asked, our current software does not have an option to email your utility bill to you.

The Clerk-Treasurer's office has been preparing for the day we open to the public. Per the Governor's Executive Order 20-26, we have outlined, shared and published our office's plan. We worked with staff and believe that we will be prepared on the first day we open the office door. Our office plan is available on Clerk-Treasurer's general information page on www.munster.org.

For those residential service addresses that have a second water meter for their sprinkler, lawn sprinkler season began on May 15 and runs until October 15. All sprinkler meters will receive a minimum charge on your July through November water bills the amount is dependent on the size of your meter. You will be charged for any usage that exceeds the minimum. If you are no longer using your lawn sprinkler, contact a plumber to discuss your options. #### Online:

- 2. Submit completed applications with supporting documents by email to communitydevelopment@munster.org.— Supporting documents may include project plans, proposal, or contract.

#### By Paper:

- 1. Download and print application
- Attach supporting documents to completed application: Supporting documents may include project plans, proposal, or contract.
- Submit complete application: Place application with all attachments in a single envelope and deposit the envelope in the large red drop box located in the Town Hall parking lot or brought into the Community Development Department.

The Community Development Department will review the application. Upon completion of review, applicant will be notified by email or phone of approval or denial and cost of the permit.

# Code Corner: Keeping you current on town code.

June is in full bloom, and as the flowers and plants grow, so do the grass and weeds. Help us keep Munster beautiful. Please be mindful that on developed residential lots,

lawns and weeds are to be kept 6" or less in height. For commercial and undeveloped lots, lawns and weeds are to be kept 10" or less in height. For more information the Town of Munster Municipal Code in its entirety can be found on-line at www.munster.org, and selecting the "Municipal Code" button.

Sec.62-113. - Permitting excessive growth of weeds, rank vegetation and grass to be declared a public nuisance.

- (a) It is a public nuisance for an owner of a developed lot or a special subdivided lot to allow weeds, rank vegetation or grass to grow to a length exceeding six inches on his property within the town.
- (b) It is a public nuisance for an owner of an undeveloped lot or other property to allow weeds, rank vegetation or grass to grow to a length exceeding ten inches on his property within the town.
- (c) Nothing herein is intended to or shall prohibit the cultivation of a garden or legally cultivated crops.

During these unusual times, we have been using yard signs to show our support for our graduates and front-line workers and to provide encouragement to our neighbors. As a reminder, temporary yard signs are allowed

without a permit in single family, two-family, or owneroccupied multi-family residences, provided they meet certain standards.

Below highlights some of the key requirements for temporary signs. The complete list can be found in the Munster zoning ordinance on our website.

- You may have up to three signs on a property at a time.
- They are to be located on the owner's property and not within the public right-of-way or parkway.
- Each sign is to be 4 square feet in area or less.
- They are to be no higher than 3 feet ( from the top of the sign to the ground).
- The signs are to be made of waterproof materials and kept in good repair - so please replace when needed.
