#### MUNSTER'S NATIONAL NIGHT OUT AGAINST CRIME TUESDAY, OCTOBER 6TH

The Munster Police Department and Choice Community Council of Munster

encourage all Munster residents to participate in Munster's 25th Annual National Night Out Against Crime Celebration, which will be held on Tuesday, October 6th from 4:00 p.m.-6:30 p.m. through police parades throughout our Munster neighborhoods. Due to the current health situation, we will be recognizing the National Night Out with thousands of other communities throughout the United States in a different way this year.

That afternoon, several groups of patrol cars, Volunteers in Police Service (VIPS) vehicles, and trucks containing our safety mascots will make their way through the neighborhoods of Munster. Volunteers wearing personal protection equipment will also be tossing out some National Night Out giveaway items from the mascot vehicles to children along the route. Residents can stand in their own front yards to waive at the police officers and mascots as they pass by, and several gift certificates for local restaurants will be randomly passed out as door prizes.

In addition, parents are encouraged to hold picnics with their individual family members that afternoon at their homes while waiting for the parades to come by. The week of the parades, the Munster Police Department will make Safety Tips for Families sheets available on the department's website (located at www.munster.org/police) which residents can download and share with their families while waiting for the parade to pass by on October 6th.

All residents and businesses are also encouraged to display blue lights on their porches or buildings on October 6th in support of police and community partnerships, and to also post photos to social media that day that display positive interaction with our Munster Police officers over the years (with the #munsternightout).

We also would like to help out our fellow residents during this difficult time by holding a Canned Food Drive at the Munster Police Department (1001 Ridge Road) on October 6th from 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. Please just bring canned goods in bags into the lobby of the station and we will make sure that they are provided to a local food pantry for people in need

# Branch Collection

Branch collection will continue in the month of October and will end on October 31, 2020 and will resume in the Spring.



#### **Political Signs in Yard**

With National and Local elections around the corner, it's time for a

refresher on the rules for posting candidate and political signs on residential property in Munster. Political signs are considered temporary yard signs and are allowed without a permit on residential properties, but must adhere to these rules:

- You may have up to three signs on a property at a time.
- Signs are to be located on the owner's property and not within the public right-of-way or parkway.
- Each sign is to be 4 square feet in area or less.
- Signs are to be no higher than 3 feet (from the top of the sign to the ground).
- The signs are to be made of waterproof materials and kept in good repair—so please replace when needed.

In keeping with State of Indiana Code 36-1-3-11, the rules change slightly during election season. Beginning 60 days before an election and ending at the beginning of the sixth day after the election, there is no limit to the number of signs and the maximum size is increased to 32 square feet.
