Medical Rates for 2021

Munster is a member of the AIM Medical Trust. This is a collection of municipalities within the State that pool their risk together in order to mitigate the negative effects of potential heavy usage. The Trust sets 60% of the renewal based upon the Trust's increase which is determined by the total claims experience of all municipalities and 40% is based upon each individual municipality's claims experience as calculated by the Trust's actuary.

This year, the Town's blended rate increase is 5%.

An additional benefit of being a member of the Trust is that the Trust can choose to strategically allocate reserves to further decrease premiums in some circumstances. Another benefit is that the Board may further reallocate fund balance back to participant members. This year, the Trust's Board (on which the Town Manager sits) voted to implement a one-month premium holiday. This means the Town will not have to pay our month medical premium to the Trust in January 2021. This is a value of approximately \$183, 458.

The rates presented include a .04% increase beyond that 8% to account for the rising administrative costs of providing: dental coverage, long-term disability insurance, our Section 125 Flexible Spending Arrangement (FSA), and our employee assistance program (EAP).

Through our membership in the Trust we will have avoided millions of dollars as compared to medical trend.

Town Employees currently share in the cost of health insurance by contributing 17.5% towards the total premium cost of the coverage they elect. The Town pays for the remaining 82.5% of the cost of insurance. It is not suggested that this is proportional cost sharing change.

Vision Rates for 2021

Employees do not have to contribute to the cost of the vision premium. Indiana State Law requires the Town Council to accept the specific rates for each line of coverage. To that end please review the 2021 Vision Rates as proposed by The Trust. There was no change in the cost of providing vision insurance this year.

Dental Rates for 2021

Munster's network for the dental care is self-funded through Delta and will remain so. The proposed rates reflect actual claims experienced in 2019. The Town is only looking to have enough money to pay claims as they occur in 2020.
