Re: Designation of Membership

Lake County Ordinance §38:15 states that Department of Homeland Security/Emergency Management, an Advisory Council may be established to provide for the exercise of necessary powers during disaster emergencies. Pursuant to Ind. Code 10-14-3-17(c) the emergency management advisory council consists of the following individuals or their designees:

- 1. The president of the county executive or, if the county executive does not have a president a member of the county executive appointed from the membership of the county executive.
- 2. The president of the county fiscal body.
- 3. The mayor of each city located in the county.
- 4. An individual representing the legislative bodies of all towns located in the county.
- 5. Representatives of private and public agencies or organizations that can assist emergency management considered appropriate by the county emergency management advisory council; or
- 6. One (1) commander of a local civil air patrol unit in the county or the commander's designee.

Retired Chief Dave Pelc is the Town's current emergency manager. The County is looking for a formal appointment of Chief Hajduk for the current year 2021.

Recommendation: By motion and voice vote designate Fire Chief Mark Hajduk the individual representing the Legislative Body of the Civil Town of Munster at the Lake County Emergency Management Advisory Council in 2021
