www.munster.org for more details. **Alcohol, fireworks, and firearms are not permitted in the park, and all bags and coolers will be checked. No shuttle buses will be providing transportation to the park.**



Fireworks may be discharged within the corporate limits from June 29th through July 3rd between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and two hours after sunset. On July 4th between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and twelve midnight.



The Munster Civic Foundation strives to enhance, enrich, and enjoy our Town. I hope you had the opportunity to enjoy the 3,000 tulips the Foundation donated to the Town. I passed many of them on Ridge Road, and they never failed to make me smile when I saw them blooming red and white. The bulbs have pulled to be replanted next year, and our summer flowers are blossoming.

The Town Council, Boards, and Commissions were given, by Executive Order, the authority to hold electronic meetings. As time passed, Town Hall has opened, and we have seen attendance at meetings shift from virtual to mostly in-person. We are awaiting a declaration to an end of the public health emergency as this declaration will change the rules for electronic meetings. Per the open-door law, all town meetings must be available for the public to simultaneously attend and observe. The Town of Munster website has meeting dates and times posted.

To residential service addresses with a second water meter for the sprinkler, Munster's lawn sprinkler meter season is between May 15th and October 15th. All sprinkler meters will receive a minimum charge on your July through November water bills, which are dependent on your meter's size. You will be charged for any usage that exceeds the minimum. If you are no longer using your lawn sprinkler, contact a plumber to discuss your options. A utility bill reminder to residents, your next utility bill (the bill that will be due on July 20th) will reflect the water and refuse rate increases. The Town offers various methods for payment with no fee, including ACH withdrawals and cash, credit card, and check payments at Town Hall. You may make your payment online through the Town of Munster website, but these payments are subject to a processing fee.

In May, we began the implementation of a much-improved software system. We are super excited about the many enhancements, and we are still learning the new program. We appreciate your patience as we are transitioning to the new program. Fire Prevention



Kidde issued a recall of more than 226,000 smoke and combination smoke/carbon monoxide detectors that may fail to sound in the event of a fire, according to the Consumer Products Safety Commission. The recall includes the Kidde TruSense Smoke Alarms and Combination Smoke/Carbon Monoxide Alarms, both which were sold at Walmart, Menards, Home Depot, Amazon, and other hardware stores between May 2019 and September 2020. Consumers are advised to contact Kidde for a replacement, free of charge.

Indiana Code 308.1.4

Indiana Code that apply to grills and open flame cooking devices - these codes apply to all multi-family dwellings. Failure to adhere to these codes will result in a violation. Open-flame cooking devices states: Charcoal burners and other open-flame cooking devices shall NOT be operated on combustible balconies or within 10 ft. of combustible construction.

Exceptions:

1. One and two family dwellings
2. Where buildings, balconies and decks are protected by an automatic sprinkler system

Open Burning 326 IAC 4-1-3, 2

Private Residential Burning, where the building contains four (4) or fewer dwelling units - Burning is prohibited in apartment and condominium complexes and mobile home parks. Burning shall be subject to conditions in subsection (b) and the following conditions:

- (A) Burning shall be in a non combustible container that:
- (i) is sufficiently vented to induce adequate primary combustion; and
 - (ii) Has enclosed sides and bottom
- (B) Only clean wood (no painted wood, garbage, plastic, tires, etc.)
- Subsection (b)
- (A) The fire shall be extinguished if it creates a:
- (i) Nuisance;
 - (ii) Fire hazard; or
 - (iii) Pollution problem
- (B) No burning shall be conducted during unfavorable meteorological conditions, such as any of the following:
- (i) High winds
 - (ii) Temperature inversions
 - (iii) Air stagnation
 - (iv) When a pollution alert or ozone action day has been declared

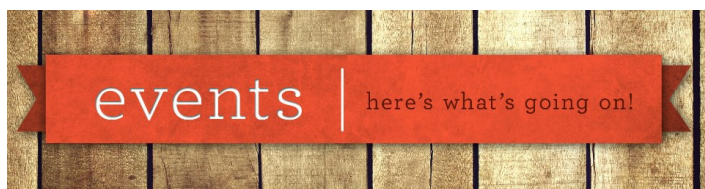
