ORDINANCE 1829

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE CDBG-COVID GRANT FUND (155)

WHEREAS, The United States Congress adopted the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Stimulus (CARES) Act in March 2020 as a response to the Coronavirus pandemic; and,

WHEREAS, Various units of government have been awarded funding from federal agencies as part of the CARES Act and other pandemic-related programs; and,

WHEREAS, The Town of Munster was allocated and has received \$30,531.00 in funding from Lake County through the Community Development Block Grant program via the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and,

WHEREAS, The Indiana State Board of Accounts has informed municipalities of the need to document receipts and expenditures of all monies received from the CARES Act to ensure compliance in a separate fund; and,

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 36-1-3 provides for the establishment of funds for accounting purposes; now, therefore, be it

ORDAINED, By the Town Council of the Town of Munster, Lake County, Indiana, that the CDBG-COVID Grant Fund (155) be created in accordance with the Indiana State Board of Accounts guidance.
