- Portable Breath test (PBT) 1072759 Alco-sensor (no longer working)
- Radar antennae Raptor Serial # RK12130
- Brite Tablet power mount-in car Serial # 191451216 (no longer functioning)
- 2 Lund power supplies Serial #s FJ1950-4523 & PA1555-655 (no longer functioning)
- Old scrap metal parts from traded in vehicles (disposed of by town in scrap metal return)
