FINDINGS OF FACT

This matter came on for Public Hearing on March 8, 2022. Applicant, Kimley-Horn & Associates on behalf of Target Corporation requests approval of multiple developmental variances from Section 26-6.405.Q Private Lighting Standards to install non-conforming parking lot lights at 8005 Calumet Avenue, Munster, Indiana. Applicant presented testimony and evidence in support of the requested variances. The Public Hearing was opened. The Public Hearing was closed.

NOW, THEREFORE, based upon the testimony and evidence presented, the Munster Board of Zoning Appeals finds as follows:

- 1. The approval will not be injurious to the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the community.
- 2. The use and value of the area adjacent to the property included in the variance will not be affected in a substantially adverse manner.
- 3. The strict application of the terms of the Zoning Ordinance will result in practical difficulties and undue hardship in the use of the property.
- 4. The Board of Zoning Appeals has given due consideration to those matters set forth in Sec. 26-456 of the Munster Municipal Code with regard to Developmental Standards Variances.
 - 5. The developmental variances granted to Applicant Target are as follows:
 - (a) From Section 26-6.405.Q.2.b Lighting Standards or Poles Maximum Height to permit 39 foot poles that exceed the maximum permitted height of 20 feet.
 - (b) From Section 26-6.405.Q.3.a Illumination to permit average illumination of Parking Areas at a level of 4.49 foot-candles which exceeds the permitted maximum average illumination of 2.5 foot-candles.
 - (c) From Section 26-6.405.Q.3.c Illumination Color Temperature Maximum to permit 4000K light fixtures that exceed the maximum color temperature of 3000K.
 - (d) From Table 26-6.26-6.405.Q-1 Private Lighting Types Head/Luminaire Types to permit a shoebox style light fixture.
- 6. The developmental variances are granted in order to install one additional light fixture on four existing light poles and two additional light fixtures on two existing poles.

7. The developmental variances are granted with the condition that a security camera will added to cover the Team Member entrance/exit from the store's dedicated Drive-Up door and the associated path to the Drive-Up stalls, and an additional security camera will be dedicated to the Drive-Up stalls.

WHEREFORE, based upon the above Findings, the Town of Munster Board of Zoning Appeals voted five (5) in favor and zero (0) opposed to approve the requested variances.
