

ORDINANCE 1868
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1841: THE MUNSTER POLICE
DEPARTMENT SPECIAL REVENUE FUND (293)

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 36-1-3 provides for the establishment of funds for accounting purposes; and,

WHEREAS, There is a need to update the uses of the Munster Police Department Special Revenue Fund (293); now, therefore, be it

ORDAINED, By the Town Council of the Town of Munster, Lake County, Indiana, that Ordinance 1841 is amended by removing Item 2 in its entirety and replacing it with the following.

2. Any monies received from the Fingerprint Service Fee, Towing Release Service Fee, any Records Service Fees (e.g. accident reports, body camera footage fees, evidentiary copies) and any locally derived seizures or forfeitures be deposited into the Police Department Special Revenue Fund 293.
