In the May *News You Can Use*, we provided a brief overview of your utility bills. We shared when your meters are typically read, how the current activities on your bill are calculated, information about the residential flow charge, and sprinkler meters. I admit it was quite a

bit to take in. To follow up I will share a bit of information about the rate increases you will see on this June bill and your July bill.



UTILITY RATE INCREASES

After many months of assessment and review, it was determined that our water rates and our sewer maintenance rates would not allow the Town to make necessary

infrastructure improvements. We need to reduce the number of water main breaks, maintain the quality of our water, and reduce the amount of water lost to water leaks. The Town was able to identify our needs for the next four years and currently, we are prioritizing our projects. Your water and sewer maintenance rates will increase annually for at least the next four years. It was a difficult decision to make, and efforts were made to minimize the impact on residents. The Town will be using American Rescue Plan money to help minimize the impact of the increase. You can expect to see us working on some of the projects this summer. We are looking forward to an improved Town of Munster not only today but for future generations.

Rental Property Regulations

The Town of Munster requires all residential rental properties to be registered with the Town and to have a Town-issued rental permit. The process for obtaining a rental permit is as follows:

- Submit a rental permit application to the Town of Munster Community Development Department.
- Pay for and schedule a rental inspection.
- The Town will inspect the property for compliance with the building codes and property maintenance standards. If the property passes inspection, the Town will issue a rental permit, and provide a rental certificate to the property owner.

The rental permit expires whenever there is a change of ownership.

Pay to Park coming to Centennial Park

The Town has engaged with Asta Parking, Inc. to manage the parking lots at Centennial Park. The details on this are being finalized and will be installed soon with an expected beginning date in mid-June.

Town of Munster residents will be able to register on a website for two free annual passes per household. Registration of your vehicle will need to be completed before using the park or you run the risk of getting a parking notice violation. Registration can be done at *http://centennialparkvehiclereg.com*. This website will be activated in June. There will not be the use of a tag or sticker for your vehicle for this process for parking validation. Instead, by registering your vehicle's license plate in the system, you can visit without paying.

Non-residents of the Town can purchase an annual parking pass for \$120 per year. Daily visitors to the park will pay the rates shown on the meter or in the app which will be set at \$2/hour or \$5/day to park. Paying for parking will be able to be done via the parking app 'ParkbyApp', using one of the parking meters at the park, or by calling the phone number on the sign at the park. Only credit/debit cards will be accepted as payment.

Enforcement will be done by license plate reading technology. License plates will be read entering the park (starting time) and exiting the park (ending time) to determine length of stay. Parking payment violations will be sent directly to the registered vehicle owner.

Parking will be validated for Dog Park annual pass holders, Golf Course members, daily golfers and rentals of facilities at Centennial Park. Information on this will be available where you registered for such membership once full details are available.

Sec. 6-10. - Removal of animal waste.

The owner of every animal shall be responsible for the removal of any excreta deposited by his animal on public walks, recreation areas or private property.

Sec. 6-5. - Restraint.

All animals shall be kept under appropriate restraint. All dogs who are off the premises of their owners or not confined in an appropriate fenced in enclosure shall be kept on a leash.
