Didier is a professional artist and maintains a studio in the Pullman Artspace near the National Monument in Chicago. He studied painting at the Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Beaux-Arts—The National School of Fine Art— in Paris, France, where he graduated with honors.

Didier's preferred mediums are oil and acrylic on canvas, and soft and oil pastel on paper. His paintings are mostly imaginary landscapes that are inspired by his childhood memories and present life, and they are reflections of his state of mind. Didier describes his artwork as contemporary romantic.

Over the past 45 years, Didier's artwork has been showcased in one-mains shows in various locations including Paris, Chicago, Minneapolis, New York, California, New Mexico, and Arizona.
