## ORDINANCE 1875

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 58-102 OF THE MUNSTER, INDIANA CODE REGARDING WATER METER SIZE

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Munster is the municipal legislative body of the unit; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Munster, its Staff, and consultants have reviewed and recommended various changes to the Munster, Indiana Code regarding required size of water meters; and

**WHEREAS**, based on those recommendations, the Munster Town Council has concluded that amendments to Chapter 58 regarding the required water meter size is appropriate; and

WHEREAS, The Munster Town Council deems it to be in the best interest of the general health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Munster to amend Chapter 58, Section 102 entitled <u>Size</u> of the Munster Code of Ordinances.

Now, therefore, be it **ORDAINED** by the Town Council of the Town of Munster, Lake County, Indiana as follows:

1. That Chapter 58, Section 102 shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

The utility will designate the size of the meter to be used for serving any customer in accordance with the following table.

Service Pipe Size	Minimum Meter Size
3/4-inch	5/8-inch
1-inch	1-inch
1½-inch	1½-inch
2-inch	2-inch
3-inch	3-inch
4-inch	4-inch

Each building to be served must be supplied by at least a three-fourths-inch service. When the service is larger than this, the utility reserves the right to designate the number of meters that can be supplied by such service.

2. That all other ordinances not specifically modified by the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall be effective from and after adoption by this Council as provided by law.

Now, therefore, be it **ORDAINED** that the above-referenced Ordinance is hereby enacted.
