The contract which only requires payment when they assist us with an animal and runs for two years but does have a clause in it where we can terminate the contract without cause if it is deemed necessary. The partnership with Humane Indiana will benefit the police department and the town by cutting down the time our Community Service Officer as well as Patrol Officers have to deal with stray animals. The contract has been reviewed by the Town attorney and we would like to move forward with this partnership as soon as possible.
