

ORDINANCE 1884

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE
OPIOID SETTLEMENT UNRESTRICTED FUND (2256)**

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 4-6-15 addresses opioid litigation and settlements; and,

WHEREAS, Indiana was part of the \$26 billion national settlement with Johnson & Johnson, AmerisourceBergen, Cardinal Health, and McKesson; and,

WHEREAS, Indiana's share of the settlement was approximately \$507 million with all cities, towns, and counties in the state participating in the settlement; and,

WHEREAS, The Town of Munster expects to receive \$106,751.04 in unrestricted funds from the settlement over the next seventeen years; and,

WHEREAS, The Indiana State Board of Accounts has stated these monies are to be accounted for in a separate fund; now, therefore, be it

ORDAINED, By the Town Council of the Town of Munster, Lake County, Indiana, that the Opioid Settlement Unrestricted Fund 2256 is created to account for the unrestricted portion of the settlement distribution which is to be used in the same manner as money in the General Fund.

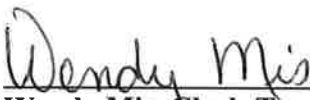
ADOPTED AND PASSED this 21st day of November 2022, by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 opposed.
